**Note that the competition fishing rules now allow 2 rods to be used of which only 1 to be pre-nominated to count throughout for the duration of any competition.**

Note 1: Booking on in advance is a commitment to pay the entry fee. See club fishing rules for more details.

Note 2: Information in "Details" column is subject to confirmation on the day.

Note A. Monkfish (*Squatina squatina* aka Angel Shark), Silver Eel, Shad & Tope must be returned unharmed in all circumstances as they are legally protected.

Porbeagle, Spurdog, Undulate Rays, Thresher & any other large shark species should also be returned.

Note B. Indicated points for rays are also applicable to any Skate & Ray comp

Note C. No size limit applies to species listed by name in the above list during points comps provided undersize fish are returned unharmed to the sea.

Note D: On general points comps where any of the listed species count, a maximum of 5 of each species to count.

Note 4: Only the above published comps including open comps carry championship points. (Min 10 entrants) Points will now be awarded to fully paid up members for the first 10 positions in any comp starting at 10 for first down to 1 for tenth plus 1 for entering & 1 for weighing in.

Note 5: Any alternative Open Comp date may revert to a normal club comp if the first date is fished. Subsequent comps may change to alternative Open Comps if weather so dictates. For competitions: minimum size limits will only apply where fish are returned to the scales.

Note 6: Started from 2009/10 Season: Entrance Fee £5.00.

Starting 2016/7 season: Each ordinary club comp **where fish are returned to the scales:**

Less than 10 entrants (No points) = 1<sup>st</sup> prize of 100% entry fees

10 to 16 entrants= 1<sup>st</sup> prize £50 plus 2nd prize of surplus entry fees

17 to 20 entrants = 1<sup>st</sup> prize £50 plus 2nd prize of £30 plus 3<sup>rd</sup> prize of surplus entry fees

21 or more entrants = 1<sup>st</sup> prize £50 plus 2nd prize of £30 plus 3<sup>rd</sup> prize of £20 with any surplus to club.

Any sweep is Optional & 100% paid out on the day

**No cash prizes for other comps. where fish are not returned to the scales**

The change to prize levels was agreed in committee taking account of further feedback from members.

Note 7. Mackerel may not be weighed in for any competitions.
