Press Release

John Gunnell of Gunner's Great Garage (two miles north of downtown Manawa on the highway) has been reviving an art career that he had dreamed of pursuing in the mid- to late-1970s. In those days, a much younger "Gunner" was studying art at Richmond College in Staten Island, N.Y. He had the opportunity to study under two well-known artists: Pat Passlof, an abstract expressionist and Lennart Anderson, who did representational paintings and later taught at the Brooklyn Museum of Art. He graduated in 1975, by which time he had started a writing career. In 1978, Gunnell moved to lola, Wis., to become an editor at Krause Publications. He did a little artwork in 1979, then his writing about classic cars started taking up more and more of his time.

Last fall, Gunnell signed up for an oil painting class at Fox Valley Technical College in Waupaca and started painting again. Last Friday (July 19) he even skipped the Iola Car Show and the Manawa Downtown Car Show to attend the opening of an art show called "Visions" at the Riverfront Art Center (RAC) in Stevens Point. The RAC is in the former Stevens Point Chamber of Commerce building near the riverfront park. The show featured the works of about 30 area artists and Gunnell's painting of a barn called "Acorn Acres" was accepted for the show.

Gunnell is also planning to enter RAC's fall "Blues Effect" show, where all artworks must be at least 90 percent blue. In addition, he is currently waiting to hear if the two paintings he submitted to a Fall Art Show at Nicolet College will be accepted for that national event. And he will be exhibiting at the Manawa Art Tour, also taking place this fall. So far, John has turned out a series of paintings of barns and nautical subjects. He has set up an art studio at Gunner's Great Garage and anyone interested in seeing his work or talking about art can visit any time he's at the shop. He is also interested in painting specific barns in the Manawa/Little Wolf areas.




