

#### **Gunner's Great Garage News Item #1**

In the "70s, John Gunnell--the owner of Gunner's Great Garage--studied art at Richmond College in his hometown of Staten Island, N.Y. He had two wellknown instructors named Pat Passlof and Lennart Anderson and dreamed of becoming an artist. But commercial art jobs didn't pay well, and "Gunner" eventually came to Iola, Wis., to work for *Old Cars Weekly*. After 30 years there, he started Gunner's Great Garage in 2010. Last year, John gave up working on customer cars and now uses the shop for writing research and appraisal work.

Now, John has an also revived his old dream of becoming an artist. He has been taking oil painting classes in Waupaca and has his work in the Union Street Emporium in Waupaca, where he has sold three pieces so far. Starting in July, he will be participating in four or five art shows (including the Manawa Art Tour in the Fall). The front room in Gunner's Great Garage is slowly being converted into an art studio. John is painting a variety of subjects including many old barns. A few samples of his work are shown here (optional).

#### Gunner's Great Garage News Item #2

Near the end of June "For Sale" signs started popping up at Gunner's Great Garage. John Gunnell will be offering his business for sale, but this will not really be a property sale. The idea is to find someone who dreams of restoring classic cars and sell them the entire business including the building, furniture, many tools and pieces of equipment, automotive literature collection, etc. In other words, the intention is to keep the business in Manawa, but possibly find a new owner for it. With the land that's included in the sale, the shop could grow into more services than Gunner's was able to offer before.

Since the offering is aimed at a targeted buyer, a quick sale may not occur, but we'll keep you posted. Jean Grenlie of Shambeau & Thern Real Estate will be handing the offering. 


