

Wamzala ke unyana wakhe wamazibulo, wamsongela eziqhiyeni, wamlalisa emkhumbini wesitali, kuba kwakungekho ndawo endlwini yabahambi. Uluka 2:4-7

Nantsi into eyoba ngumqondiso kuni: nofumana usana lusongelwe eziqhiyeni, lulele emkhumbini wesitali.” Ngequbuliso kwabakho inkitha yezithunywa zezulu, ikunye nesithunywa eso, idumisa uThixo, isithi:

“Makadunyiswe uThixo kweliphezulu, kube luxolo emhlabeni kubantu abamkholisayo.”



Babephuma besiya kuye bonke abakwa-Juda nabaseJerusalem, bezixela izono zabo, aze ababhaptize emlanjeni iJordan. UYohane wayesambatha ingubo yoboya benkamela, abhinqe ngethwathwa. Wayesitya iinkumbi nobusi. Wayeshumayela esithi: “Lowo uza emva kwam unamandla kunam. Bendingubani mna kakade ukuba ndingade ndikhulule imitya yezihlangu zakhe? Mna okunene ndinibhaptiza ngamanzi, kodwa yena uya kunibhaptiza ngoMoya oyiNgcwele.” Ngaloo mihla ke weza uYesu, evela eNazarete kwelaseGalili, wabhaptizwa nguYohane eJordan apho. 

Kwathi uYesu akukhangela, wabona isihlwele esikhulu sisiza kuye, waza wathi kuFilipu: “Ngaba sinokusithenga phi na isonka esaneleyo sokutyisa le ndimbane?” Esitsho nje, wayevavanya uFilipu, kuba yena wayekwazi oko aza kukwenza. Waphendula uFilipu, wathi: “Ngathi nesonka samakhulu amabini eerandi asingekhe sanele okokuba wonke okhoyo afumane iqhekezana.” Omnye wabafundi bakaYesu, uAndriya, umntakwabo-Simon Petros, wathi kuye: “Kukho inkwenkwana apha enezonka ezihlanu zerhasi, neentlanzi ezimbini; kodwa kuyintoni na oko kule nginginya yabantu?” Waza uYesu wathi: “Bahlaliseni phantsi abantu.” Kwakukho ibala elikhulu elinengca apho, baza bahlala phantsi. Inani lamadoda lalikumawaka amahlanu. Wazithatha ke uYesu ezo zonka, wabulela kuThixo, wababela abantu ababehleli phantsi. Wenjenjalo nakwiintlanzi, baza batya banela. Bakuhlutha abantu, uYesu wathi kubafundi bakhe: “Qokelelani okuseleyo. Makungabikho nentwana emoshakalayo.” Bawaqokelela ke amaqhekeza aseleyo ezo zonka zihlanu zerhasi, kwazala iingobozi ezilishumi elinambini. Bakuwubona abantu lo mqondiso uYesu awenzileyo, bathi: “Ngenene, kuthe kanti nguye lo umshumayeli obekade elindelwe!”

Uyohane 6:5-14

Then Jesus lifted up His eyes, and seeing a great multitude coming toward Him, He said to Philip, “Where shall we buy bread, that these may eat?” But this He said to test him, for He himself knew what He would do. Philip answered Him, “Two hundred denarii worth of bread is not sufficient for them, that every one of them may have a little.” One of His disciples, Andrew, Simon Peter’s brother, said to Him, “There is a lad here who has five barley loaves and two small fish, but what are they among so many?” Then Jesus said, “Make the people sit down.” Now there was much grass in the place. So the men sat down, in number about five thousand. And Jesus took the loaves, and when He had given thanks He distributed them to the disciples, and the disciples to those sitting down; and likewise of the fish, as much as they wanted. So when they were filled, He said to His disciples, “Gather up the fragments that remain, so that nothing is lost.” Therefore they gathered them up, and filled twelve baskets with the fragments of the five barley loaves which were left over by those who had eaten. Amanzi olwandle ayesilwa, kuba kwakuvuthuza umoya. Kwathi, bakuba begqibe iikhilomitha ezintlanu okanye ezintandathu bebheqa isikhitshana, babona nanko uYesu ehamba phezu kwamanzi olwandle, esondela. Boyika ke, kodwa uYesu wathi kubo: “Ndim; sanukoyika.” Bamamkela ke esikhitshaneni, kwathi kwangoko isikhitshana safika kuloo ndawo babesiya kuyo.

Wawuthatha ke uJosefu umzimba kaYesu, wawusongela ngelinen ecocekileyo, wawubeka kwelakhe ingcwaba awayesand' ukulixhola eliweni; waza waqengqa ilitye elikhulu, walivala ngalo ingcwaba, wemka. Babelapho ngasengcwabeni ooMariya waseMagadala nomnye uMariya, behleli phantsi bebukele. UMatewu 27:57-61

Now when evening had come, there came a rich man from Arimathea, named Joseph, who himself had also become a disciple of Jesus. This man went to Pilate and asked for the body of Jesus. Then Pilate commanded the body to be given to him. 

Matthew 27:57-61



Kwakusekusasa ngeCawe ukunduluka kwâbo bafazi besiya engcwabeni, bephethe iziqholo ababezilungisile. Balifumana ilitye liqengqiwe, lisusiwe engcwabeni. Bakuba bengenile, abawufumananga umzimba weNkosi uYesu. Kwathi, besakhohliwe yile nto, kwathi gqi amadoda amabini ngakubo, enezambatho ezibengezelayo. Basuka boyika abafazi, baqondela phantsi, aza athi loo madoda: “Yini na ukuba ophilayo nimfune kwabafileyo? [Akakho apha, uvukile.] Khumbulani awakuthetha kuni esekwelaseGalili, esithi: ‘UNyana woLuntu umelwe kukunikelwa ezandleni zaboni, abethelelwe emnqamlezweni, athi ngomhla wesithathu abuye avuke.’” Bawakhumbula ke amazwi akhe.

ULuka 24:1-8


Now on the first day of the week, very early in the morning, they, and certain other women with them, came to the tomb bringing the spices which they had prepared. But they found the stone rolled away from the tomb. Then they went in and did not find the body of the Lord Jesus. And it happened, as they were greatly perplexed about this, that behold, two men stood by them in shining garments. Then, as they were afraid and bowed their faces to the earth, they said to them, “Why do you seek the living among the dead? He is not here, but is *risen!* Remember how He spoke to you when He was still in Galilee, saying, ‘The Son of Man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men, and be crucified, and the third day rise again.’” And they remembered His words. Besuka kwangelo lixa, babuyela eJerusalem, babafumana abafundi abalishumi elinanye behlanganisene ndawonye kunye nâbo babenabo, besithi: “Inene, iNkosi ivukile! Ibonakele kuSimon.” Bakubalisa ke okwenzeke endleleni, nokutyhileka kweNkosi kubo xa yayiqhekeza isonka. Ke kaloku, besazithetha ezi zinto, uYesu ngenkqu wema phakathi kwabo, [wathi kubo: “Uxolo malube nani.”] Basuka bankwantya, baba babona into engengomntu ncam. Wathi kubo: “Yini na ukuba nothuke? Kutheni na ukuba nibe nentandabuzo? Khangelani izandla zam, niqonde ukuba ndim kanye. Ndiphatheni niqondisise ukuba ndingumntu, ndinenyama namathambo, njengoko nindibona ndinjalo.” [Etshilo wababonisa izandla neenyawo zakhe.]

ULuka 24:33-40
