

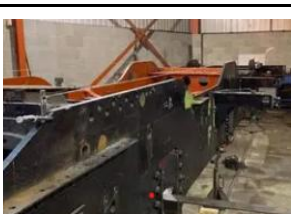
LMS10000 Chassis Preparation Sponsorship Scheme

Step 1: Initial Preparation

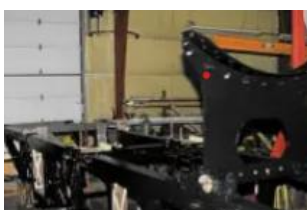
Lot No C101	Shunting Chassis	Unit donation: £200	Available Units: 1	
Our Class 58 donor chassis is currently being stored on a low load wagon on a siding at the Ecclesbourne Valley Railway and which need to be moved to the workshop on the railway using the railway shunting engine Attend on the day and/or we will send you pictures/videos.

Jacks will lift the Chassis to a position to allow it to be worked on in the workshop

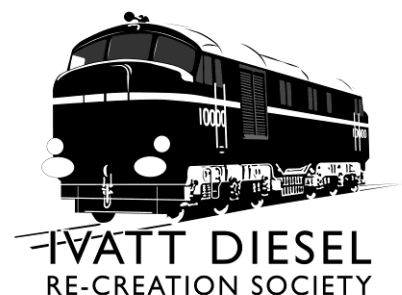
Lot No C301	Fabricating adapter plates for bogies	Unit donation: £1000	Available units: 4

A crucial piece of work will be to fit the adapter plates to Chassis requiring a professional expert welder.				
Lot No C303	Fabricating and fitting Chassis side bearers	Unit donation: £1000	Available units: 2	
The Class 58 Chassis will require various modifications to support new fittings.				
Lot No C304	Chassis reinforcement welding	Unit donation: £100	Available units: 6
