

Application for the "Cleared For Takeoff" Scholarship

The Nashville Chapter of the Ninety-Nines is offering the Cleared For Takeoff Scholarship to support female pilots who are taking steps forward in order to obtain their goals in aviation. The deadline for applications to be received is May 1st, 2025 at 11:59 p.m. Central Daylight Time.

The award entitles the following:

- 1. Two hours of complex time instructed by CFI Jim Jones. Aircraft will be provided by him. The recipient and the CFI will coordinate a time that works for both.
- 2. Up to \$175 to be used toward any FAA written test.
- 3. \$250 to be used for schooling purposes in the aeronautical field.
- 4. A one year "Performance Plus" ForeFlight Subscription.

Please read the following requirements and instructions very carefully and thoroughly.

- I. To be eligible, you must be:
 - 1. At least 18 years old.
 - 2. A current member of the International Ninety-Nines prior to, or on the date that the scholarship application is dated and signed.
 - 3. Living in, or be a permanent resident of the state of Tennessee.
 - 4. Must not have taken the written test in which you are applying to prior to award being given.
 - 5. Hold a private pilot certificate.

- 3. What FAA written test you will use the funds toward.

- 2. Ability to be an ambassador, representing women in aviation
- 3. Drive and commitment to reaching your goals
- 4. Complete, clear and concise application package
- 5. Demonstration of financial need

VII. Please note that no applicant eligibility requirements or deadlines may be waived. Disqualification will result from not meeting eligibility requirements or following procedures. INCOMPLETE, LATE, or FRAUDULENT applications will be DISQUALIFIED.

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I understand that the \$250 must be used for aviation purposes. Funds must be used within 90 days of recipient notification and will be paid directly to me via reimbursement upon proof of receipt.
