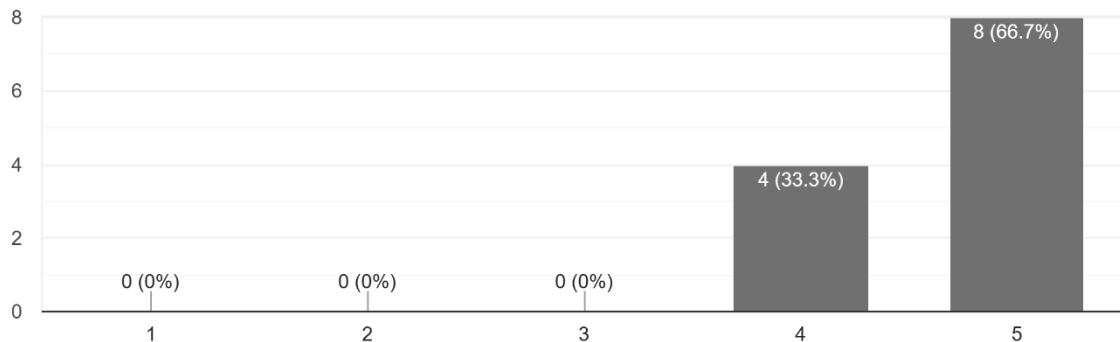

How satisfied were you overall with the training?

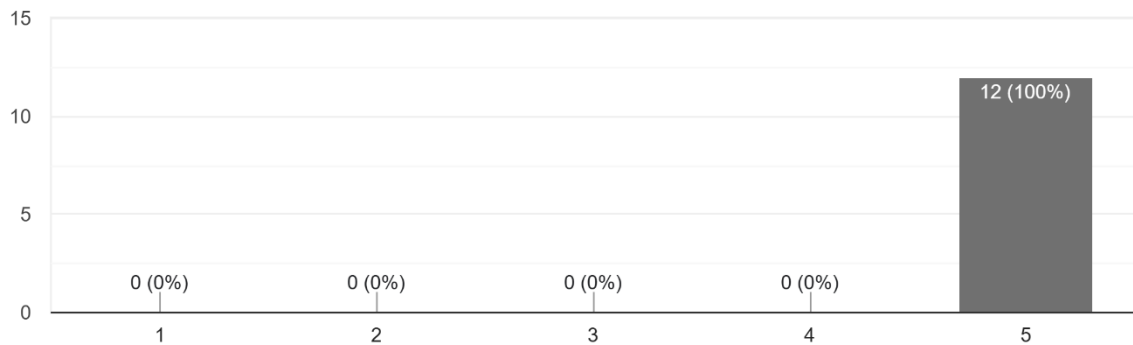

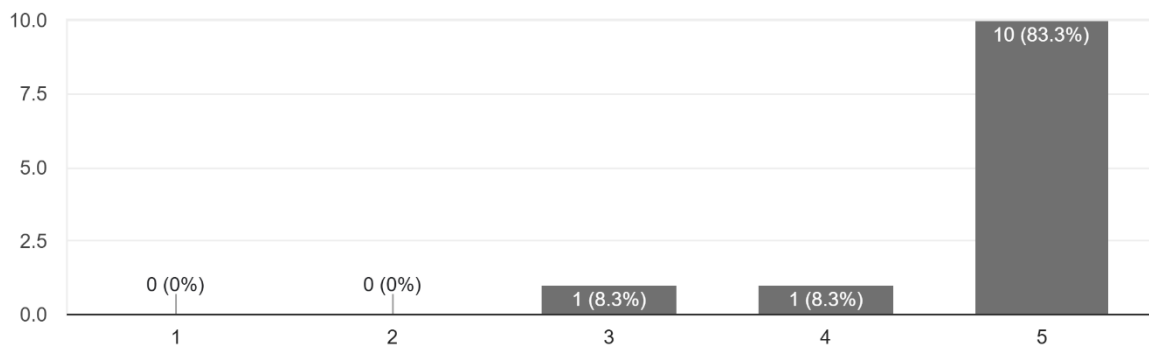
