Looking Forward in Hope

Hope is a funny thing. Hope carries with it a presupposition of something that is, at the very least, not yet fulfilled if not downright disappointing or even tragic.

The hope I am living in right now is rooted in a disappointment.

But hope is also rooted in faith. It is rooted in the trust that God is with me in the midst of disappointment and that God will be with me in the future. This trust is, in part, based upon my experience that God has seen me through such situations in the past, and though I do not know how things will work out, I do not need to fear, because God and the people of God are with me.

I've been through my current disappointment and anxiety for the future four times before in my ministry. Something over 20 years ago, Jeanne decided to retire as the secretary at St. Paul's Lutheran Church. Twelve or 15 years later, Carol informed me that she was moving to another town and resigned from the same position. A few years later, Stephanie and her family moved to Arizona and she informed me that it would be too far to commute for a part-time job as our church secretary. (I managed to re-

sign as the Pastor of St. Paul's before her successor, Megan, was able to resign.) In 2021, I was serving as the Interim Pastor at Lakeview Lutheran Church and Laura, who was working as our Office Administrator and studying as a part-time student at Wartburg Seminary announced that in the fall, her family would be moving closer to Dubuque and she would be attending the seminary full-time. (Laura was ordained as an ELCA Pastor earlier this year.)

Each time, I greeted the announcement with my own disappointment and increased anxiety. I did the same thing when Ann first informed me that she applied for a full-time position at the Muskego Public Library. (I was also secretly pleased when she did not get a call to interview over the next month – and then was dismayed when she did get that call.) In each case I was able to overcome my anxiety and fear and be happy and excited for the new possibilities for each person and her family, and I am genuinely pleased for Ann. I am also hopeful that God will be with us at North Cape as we look for a new Office Manager.

But there is something else about my disappointment in each of these resignations. It is that each of these women (as well as those who outlasted me in congregations) has supported and sustained me in my ministry and the ministry of the congregation they served. Through their goodwill, their friendship, their dedication, skill, and knowledge they have worked hard in support of the work of the Gospel and made my own work both better and more effective. And this has been most certainly true of Ann.

Thank you Ann, and May God's Blessings be with you in your new calling.

Our offerings for 2025 are still above our offerings for last year as are our expenses. In addition to this, we have gathered some \$90,000 for our new sound system from memorials and donations from our members. Thank you to you all for your support of the work we share here at North Cape.

Offerings to congregations typically increase over the last quarter of the year as members consider if they have met their goals for their offerings to the church during the year and think about how they might be able to grow in their offerings in the coming year.

Thank you for taking time to review what you have given to North Cape this year. If you are not certain of what you have given, you may contact the church office or Laurel Rybka for that information.




