Carrying the Scriptures with You

From the Interim Pastor's Desk...

Do you carry the scriptures with you?

No, I don't mean, do you carry a bible around with you, or do you have a bible near at hand in your living room or bedroom.

What I mean is, do you have certain parts of the bible that you carry around inside of you? Do you have certain passages, stories or sayings of Jesus or lines from the Psalms or St. Paul, that have stuck in your mind and keep coming back to you throughout your life? Are there parts of the bible that have influenced you and shaped the person you are? Are there passages that have comforted you, challenged you, supported you, or changed you in some way?

If so, then what are they? I would like to know what they are and how they have shaped you.

When I was confirmed at Redeemer Lutheran Church in South Charleston, WV, some 40 years ago now, my pastor gave me a Confirmation verse. Micah 6:8 – He has told you, O mortal, what is good; and what does the Lord require of you but to do justice, and to love kindness, and to walk humbly with your God? Perhaps my pastor gave me this verse because he thought that it reflected who I was, but I also think that over the years it has shaped me and guided me as a person.

John 15:5 – I am the vine, you are the branches. Those who abide in me and I in them bear much fruit, because apart from me you can do nothing. This is another verse I remember from my time in confirmation. Jesus is speaking. Jesus is the vine, the one who feeds us and gives us life so that we can bare good fruit in our lives.

Galatians 5:22-23 – ...the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control... My Mom cross-stitched this, and it is hanging the wall in her kitchen. She used a different translation in which, I think, it is patience is translated as long suffering. The cross-stitch is in caps and she left part of the word out so that it read "LONG SUFFFRING." I often teased her about that once, as a snotty kid, I had noticed it, but the fruits of the spirit have always stuck in my mind.

Habakkuk 3:17-19 – Though the fig tree does not blossom, and no fruit is on the vines; though the produce of the olive fails, and the fields yield no food; though the flock is cut off from the fold, and there is no herd in the stalls, yet I will rejoice in the Lord; I will exult in the God of my salvation. God, the Lord, is my strength; he makes my feet like the feet of a deer, and makes me tread upon the heights.

I know...who ever reads Habakkuk. Three chapters in the midst of the unpronounceable minor prophets. I came across this passage maybe 15 or 18 years ago - not that it was the first time I'd read it, but it was the first time it had really caught me, and I have carried it with me since. I see it as a passage of hope, a passage that helps me through depression, a passage that assures me that God is with me even when I am not seeing or feeling the presence of God. That little word "yet." In spite of everything – yet, I will rejoice in the Lord. I find that powerful and helpful.

One last passage I will share with you, from Isaiah. I will let it speak for itself. Isaiah 43:1-4a – But now thus says the Lord, he who created you, O Jacob, he who formed you, O Israel: Do nor fear, for I have redeemed you; I have called you by name, you are mine. When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and through the rivers, they shall not overwhelm you; when you walk through fire you shall not be burned, and the flame shall not consume you. For I am the Lord your God, the Holy One of Israel, your Savior. I give Egypt as your ransom, Ethiopia and Seba in exchange for you. Because you are precious in my sight, and honored, and I love you...

Endowment Fund Will Distribute \$4,900 in 2025

The Endowment Committee approved a \$4,900 distribution from the North Cape Lutheran Endowment Fund for 2025. The distribution is based on 4% of the endowment fund value as of December 31, 2024 =\$121,194.35. The distribution will support church capital improvements and community outreach by our congregation, including:

- **\$4,410** (90% of distribution): Designated towards the sound system repair project, and the 50% required to sign a contract to complete upgrades.
- \$490 (10% of distribution): A donation will be made to the Women's Resource Center of Racine, which provides housing and resources to women and their children in need in Racine County.

As a reminder, the 2023 & 2024 capital distributions of \$7,830 were designated to assist with the front step repair project completed last fall.

The Endowment Fund is intended to support important capital projects that help maintain and enhance our church and congregation. Your contribution to the Endowment Fund as charitable giving can help us make an even larger impact on our congregation.

Lutherdale Bible Camp




