## Glimpse of Lenten Worship

I began my time at North Cape Lutheran by preaching on the Christmas story in Matthew, Luke, and John. At the Annual Meeting you will have the vote you have been waiting almost 3 years to take, a vote to call a new pastor. A final date for my time with you can't be set until after the vote but with Ash Wednesday on February 18, 2026, I am confident we will at least start Lent together.

Our Lenten series this year will be Jesus' Ministry: Between the Manger and the Cross. Each week we will focus on a different theme: Parables, Teachings, Encounters, Healings, and Miracles. Think about your favorite stories from the Gospels, which category do they fall into? Some stories are easy to place - the Sermon on the Mount is clearly teaching and parables are parables (a distinct type of teaching, think all squares are rectangles but not all rectangles are squares).

But there are also stories that might fit into more than one category. Jesus' teaching that includes John 3:16 will be the preaching text kicking off the teaching week but it could also have been put under encounters because this teaching was to a crowd or the disciples but to a single seeker, Nicodemus. The

Good Samaritan is one of the most well known parables but it too could be put under encounters because it is told in loving response to the individual who asked the question, "Who is my neighbor?" Join us in person or online for worship on Sundays and Wednesdays to hear sermons on Bible stories from that week's theme. If you are looking for a Lenten Devotional Practice you could use the daily reading list provided. I encourage you to try the Dwelling in the Word format of Bible study, either alone or with others.

**Meeting called to order by President, Les Gumienny**

**Pastoral Candidate Zoom Meeting**

NCLC’s pastoral candidate called into the Council Meeting so she could introduce herself via Zoom. We are looking forward to January 23rd – 25th when she will be at NCLC to meet with the entire congregation.

**Worship Update**

- Ash Wednesday is February 18, 2026. Pastor Sheila is planning our Lenten worship season.
- Easter Sunday is April 5, 2026. Worship services will be at 7 and 9:30am with an Easter breakfast served in between services

**Meet and Greet Planning**

Our Pastoral candidate will be at North Cape January 23-25. The Congregation will host a Meet and Greet Potluck on Saturday Jan. 24th at 4 pm. WELCA is purchasing chicken for the dinner. Members are requested to bring a dish to pass. On Sunday the candidate will attend both worship services.

**Annual Meeting Pastor Call**

There will only be one service on February 1, 2026 at 9am. Our Annual Meeting will immediately follow the 9am service. At that meeting we will also vote whether we should call the Pastoral Candidate to be our Pastor.

**Budget Discussion**

As discussed at the December meeting Linda Spencer updated the Budget for the 2025 actual year-end numbers. The Budget will be given to Alyssa for inclusion in the 2025 annual report.

**Nominating Committee Update**

The Nominating Committee is recommending 2 members for next year’s Council. One nominee is still needed for both the audit and endowment committees.

**Financials**

Our 2025 annual General Fund Revenue was \$243,917 compared to the 2024 General Fund Revenue of \$230,017. This is a 6 % increase. This does not include the funds raised for our new sound system purchased this year. Our 2025 annual General Fund Expenses were \$309,672 compared to the 2024 General Fund Expenses of \$365,285.

**Committee Updates**

The El Salvador Committee is planning another visit to our sister church this fall. The Youth Committee held its annual Jamboree. Attendance was great, a good time was had and the Youth Group raised a lot of money.

If you have a family member serving in the armed forces that you wanted to be added or removed from the prayer list—please let us know.


