I will be doing the rest of my work remotely. As you have probably already figured out, the church doesn't move quickly. Once your call committee find the right pastor it could still take 2+ months before you get to officially welcome your new pastor. Even though I won't be here long I like to introduce myself and hope you will do likewise.

### **10 Fun Facts about Pastor Sheila Rawn in no particular order:**

- 1) I have two kids - Eren is a junior at Hamline in St Paul, MN and Jacob is a senior at Harborside Academy in Kenosha
