## The 4th Verse

Now the green blade rises, from the buried grain, wheat that in the dark earth many days has lain; love lives again, that with the dead has been; love is come again like wheat arising green.

This is the first verse of the hymn "Now the Green Blade Rises" (#379 in our hymnals). It is a hymn for the Easter season.

The 2nd and 3rd verses compare Jesus to a grain of wheat. After his crucifixion, he is laid in the earth "never to rise again." But then, at Easter, Jesus rises from the grave "like wheat arising green."

That's all well and good, but the hymn does not stop there. There is a 4th verse, and we need the 4th verses. Just as when we read so many stories in the Bible, we are compelled to see that there is, what I am going to call, a 4th verse. This 4th verse redirects our attention away from the story and back toward our own lives. For instance, when we read stories of Jesus' miracles in the Bible, it helps if

we see them as more than just historical stories. If Jesus healing the blind man, or feeding the hungry crowd, are just historical stories, if we end on the 3rd verse, it does not go far enough. I mean, it was really lucky for that particular blind man to be in that place that day, and it worked out well for the crowd who got to eat their fill when they thought they might have a hungry night ahead, but what about the other blind men and women and the other hungry crowds? And what about us?

That's where the 4th verse comes in. The 4th verse tells us that Jesus restores our sight when we are blind, that Jesus feeds us when we are hungry, that Jesus cares for those who are in need. The 4th verse proclaims that the Gospel message is for you and me and for all of our hurting and yearning world.

The 4th verse:

When our hearts are wintry, grieving, or in pain; your touch can call us back to life again, fields of our hearts that dead and bare have been; love is come again like wheat arising green.

The 4th verse is telling us that Jesus' resurrection is not just some past event, but it is an event that continues to happen – in my life and in your life. Wherever we find the power of death filling our hearts, resurrection is the power of God to restore us to life, to bring us hope and promise and love. Yes, one day there will be that final resurrection, but the resurrection promise is not just for our death, it is also for our life. It is for here and now, for next year, for when we find ourselves in need, then love will "come again like wheat arising green."

Consent Agenda Items February Minutes

Meeting called to order by President, Les Gumieny. Consent Agenda Item: February Minutes approved

In February each Council member was tasked with listing 3 goals believed to be vital to the life of the congregation. The Council member goals are listed below. Note some goals are duplicated:

- 1. Fill the Pastoral vacancy
- 2. Start a stewardship program
- 3. Improve Membership growth
- 4. Invite the parents who drop kids off for Sunday School to church
- 5. Fix the church front steps
- 6. Reinstate the bell choir
- 7. Form a call committee
- 8. Complete the MET team function
- 9. Complete the Church Constitution and By-Laws update
- 10. Create an updated Church Committee Structure
- 11. Select Council Members to act as liaisons to the various NCLC Committees. Currently the Church by-laws stipulate 6 NCLC committees.

#### **Financials**

February 2024 donations exceeded February expenses. This is positive as typically February is a low donation month. A long-term savings account at Town Bank was moved to Community State Bank. This account is now listed on the financials as item 1970 certificate of deposit. All NCLC accounts are located at Community State Bank.

#### **Committee Updates**

- The Mission quilters donated \$500 to NCLC for occupancy costs.

<u>Pavilion</u> The Committee is scheduling the Pavilion dedication and meal with music on Saturday, June 8, 2024 from 7–9 pm.

<u>Property</u> The front steps, sidewalk and planter designs are being collected and processed.

The committee requested Council input for selecting a financial goal to receive the benefit of its funds. The Council believes golf outing funds should be used to fix the church front steps. Any additional funds should be donated to the Cemetery.

Subject: Pavilion update

Dear Members in Christ at North Cape Lutheran Church,

As you know the Pavilion project has completed the first three phases and is ready for usage. We are in the final planning stages for completion of the memorial sign and reflection bench. We plan to have this completed by Mid-May 2024. There will be a flower planter on both ends of the stone wall, a reflection bench, lighting, as well as the sign holder designed to match the Pavilion look.

Going forward the committee is working on Phases 4-5 initial planning and timelines. In the meantime we are working on the following:

- Dedication event with food and music tentatively set for Saturday, June 8<sup>th</sup>. Invitations will be coming soon inviting the congregation and community as a thank you for the support that delivered this beautiful addition to our church property.
- Looking at 4-6 lightweight mesh picnic tables for inside the Pavilion for small event usage
- Adding two temporary port- a- potties for 2024 summer usage until we can develop a longer term plan
- Alyssa Neusen, the Pavilion Manager, is actively seeking out members and nonmembers for usage of this facility. (Weddings, Funerals, Craft Shows, Graduations, etc)
- Encouraging the ministry planning teams to hold at least monthly church services outside during the summer

In the spring of 2023 we announced the capital campaign with a goal of raising \$75,000 for the Pavilion by April 1, 2024. We have been so fortunate to date to have raised over \$58,000. We currently have over \$11,000 in our funding to complete the memorial signage and some of the activities mentioned above. We are still open to any new memorials or donations for those who might like to be a part of the memorial sign. Please prayerfully consider and use the memorial form to make your donation by April 1. If we deliver the \$75,000 goal, we will use the funding to begin work on the final two phases which include bathroom access and a patio between the east side of the church and Pavilion.

Thank you all again for supporting this project. Please tell your friends and neighbors...better yet, invite them to join one of our summer events in the Pavilion as we try to maximize its usage.
