## Bread

*From the Interim Pastor's Desk...*

Once again, we are approaching an inescapable moment. Every third year, in July or August, we are led into the whirlwinds and spirals of John, chapter 6. For weeks on end we are caught up in the dizzying language of John, the Gospel writer, in which Jesus talks about bread and manna from heaven and being the bread of life.

It all starts rather innocently, with Jesus feeding the hungry crowds, but after the crowds of people hunt him down, Jesus starts to explain the significance of what just happened. Jesus himself is the bread of life, the true bread from heaven, the living bread who gives life to the world, who, indeed, will give his life for the world.

As is often the case in John's gospel, the language gets a bit confusing, and when you are reading it, you really have to pay attention. There are allusions to Holy Communion, of eating the body of Christ and drinking the blood of Christ.

One of the spiritual truths that the chapter is conveying to us is that, in our faith in Jesus, our lives become wrapped up in the life of Jesus. As we eat and drink the bread and wine of Holy Communion – the body and blood of Jesus – Jesus becomes a part of us. Jesus begins to live in and through us. We become the body of Christ in the world.

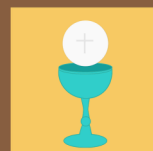
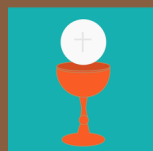
Practically speaking, we become the ones who are now living out the Mission of Jesus in the world. It is now our job to proclaim the message that Jesus proclaimed.

We've all heard it said that "you are what you eat." Well, we are the body of the Christ, the bread of life for the world. We are called to feed the hungry – both spiritually and physically – with the bread of life, Jesus Christ our Lord.

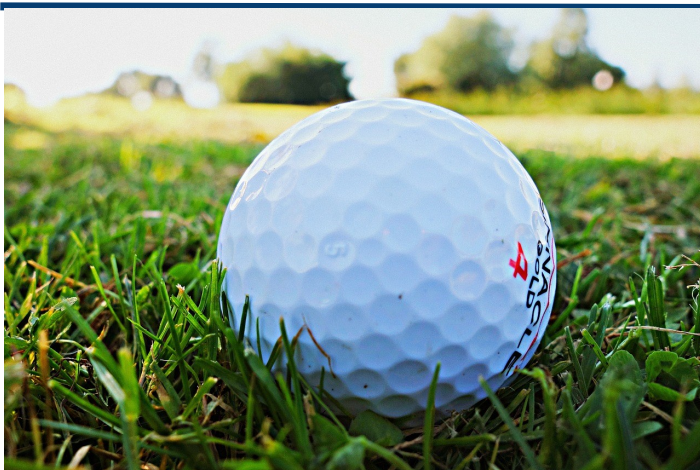

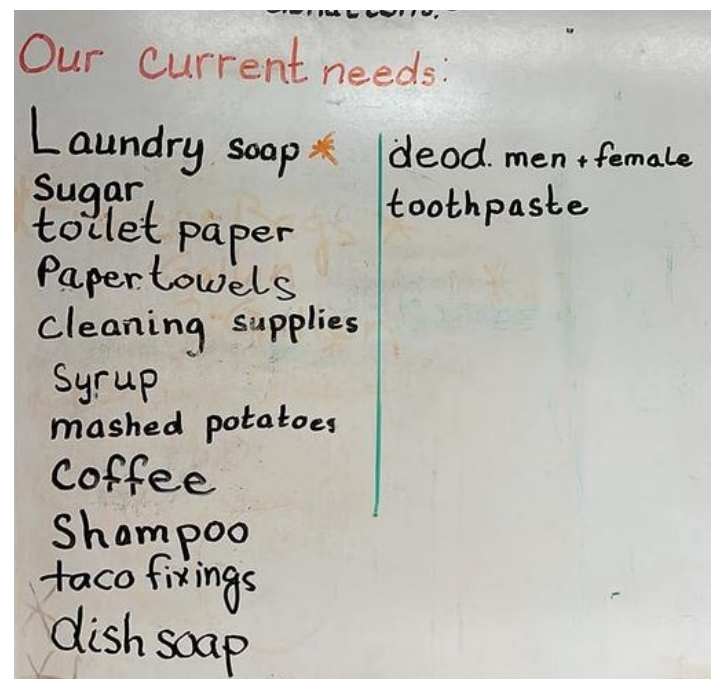
