We want you to be completely honest with your feelings, sharing your needs and opinions on who we are as a church family, our strengths and weaknesses as a church family, and what you, as individuals, are looking for in fulfilling your pastoral needs. The council is committed to helping our congregation through this process, along with the committed assistance of the ELCA.

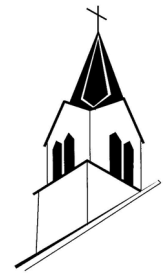
## Tables and Chairs Available

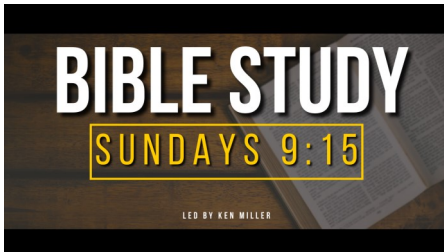

## LWR Kits Needs

Your help is needed!! Looking ahead optimistically, and by the Grace of God, I am hoping to keep assembling the LWR Kits on “good” days during my cancer therapy this coming year. There are enough quality baby clothes and blankets already toted up.

- What is really needed is many, many bars of mild hand soap. Dollar Tree (3/\$1.25), Walmart (10/\$4.97) or Menards (10/\$3.98) are some of the places I have found mild soap very reasonably priced. It does not need to be Dove.
- We also need large-tooth combs. I have found large tooth combs reasonably priced at Walmart and Dollar General as well as on Amazon.
- NEW dark hand and bath towels-not your luxury variety are needed. I have found great deals at Kohls using their sales, my % off promos, and Kohls cash.
- Diapers are needed for the baby care kits- flat-fold or pre-fold diapers. Diapers can be made from flannel, approx. 22x27, then pinked around edges and zigzagged on the edges. They are also available on Amazon and Walmart for 10/\$14.99. If ordered online at Walmart, they are 10/\$12.84.

As always, any items are most welcome for this ministry for our far-away neighbors. I like to imagine that some of these kits may be going to our neighbors in the Ukraine. Please see complete instructions and supplies needed for the kits on the next page of this newsletter, on the LWR website, or in the binders on the Welcome Center. There are about 25 kits already assembled for this year's distribution.

## PERSONAL CARE KITS



### SOME IMPORTANT GUIDELINES TO REMEMBER

- Please include sizes between 6 and 24 months. Varying the sizes of the clothing items included will make the Baby Care Kit useful as the baby grows.
- Sweaters may be knitted or crocheted from leftover yarn, or made from heavy double knits. Select a pattern that suits your skill level. Preferred styles have buttons or ties down the front.
- Diapers can be made from flannel or even by recycling t-shirts. [Download a Diaper Tip Sheet from our website.](#)
- If knitting or crocheting receiving blankets, including one knitted/crocheted blanket and one flannel blanket will provide maximum versatility.
- Onesies can be cut and hemmed or serged to make a simple t-shirt.
- Gowns, rompers or top/pants sets can be substituted for sleepers.
- Gently used, clean clothing and blankets (no stains or tears) may be substituted for new ones. It is especially important that the items be in excellent condition, as used clothing is increasingly difficult to get through customs in many countries. Even one item that looks worn or stained to local officials can jeopardize the status of a whole shipment. All other items (diapers, towel, soap) in the kit must be new.
- Please do not donate items with any religious symbols, messages or your group's name.
- Please do not donate any items decorated with a U.S. flag, patriotic or military symbols, or references to the armed forces, including camouflage.
- Do not add other items or leave out any of the items listed.
- Do not enclose the kit or any of its contents in plastic bags.

### INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING IN EACH BABY CARE KIT

- TWO** lightweight cotton t-shirts (no Onesies ®)
- TWO** long- or short-sleeved gowns or sleepers (without feet)
- TWO** receiving blankets, medium-weight cotton or flannel, or crocheted or knitted with lightweight yarn, between 36" and 52" square
- FOUR** cloth diapers, flat fold preferred
- ONE** jacket, sweater or sweatshirt with a hood, or include a baby cap
- TWO** pairs of socks
- ONE** hand towel, dark color recommended
- TWO** or three bath-size bars of gentle soap equaling 8 to 9 oz., any brand, in original wrapping: no mini or hotel size bars
- TWO** diaper pins or large safety pins

### HOW TO PACK YOUR KITS OF CARE

- Wrap items in one of the receiving blankets and secure with diaper pins.
- Pack completed kits, like items together, in boxes. Label contents in **LARGE, BLOCK LETTERS** on the outside of the boxes.
- Use strong cartons secured with packing tape, not to exceed 40 pounds.
- Do not use plastic or paper bags to pack donations.
- Include the name and address of your group or congregation on each box and label the contents

### SOME IMPORTANT GUIDELINES TO REMEMBER

- Be sure to shop for light- or medium-weight towels, which are easier for kit recipients to hand wash and air dry, take up less storage space and are considerably less expensive than the fluffier towels we may prefer to use.
- Bath towels vary in size. The 52" X 27" size listed in the guidelines is the maximum size. 20" x 40" is a good guideline for a minimum size.
- Please give new items only.
- Please do not donate items with any religious symbols, messages or your group's name.
- Please do not donate any items decorated with a U.S. flag, patriotic or military symbols, or references to the armed forces, including camouflage.
- Do not add other items or leave out any of the items listed.
- All items should be new and in good condition.
- Do not enclose the kit or any of its contents in plastic bags.

### INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING IN EACH PERSONAL CARE KIT

- ONE** light-weight bath-size towel (between 20" x 40" and 52" x 27"), dark color recommended
- TWO** or three bath-size bars of soap equaling 8 to 9 oz., any brand, in original wrapping
- ONE** adult-size toothbrush in its original packaging\*
- ONE** sturdy comb, remove packaging
- ONE** metal nail clippers (attached file optional), remove packaging

\* Toothbrush multi-packs may be used by sealing an individual toothbrush in a business-size envelope; no plastic bags or wrap

### HOW TO PACK YOUR PROJECT PROMISE KITS

- Fold the towel in half. Place the rest of the items in the towel, fold and roll so nothing falls out, and secure with yarn, ribbon, string or rubber bands.
- Pack completed Kits, like items together, in boxes. Label contents in **LARGE, BLOCK LETTERS** on the outside of the boxes.
- Use strong cartons secured with packing tape, not to exceed 40 pounds.
- Do not use plastic or paper bags to pack donations.
- Include the name and address of your group or congregation on each box and label the contents
