Nearsighted

From the Interim Pastor's Desk...

I was in third grade at Weberwood Elementary School in Charleston, WV. I have a vague memory of telling my mom that I couldn't see the chalkboard very well. I don't actually remember that I couldn't see the chalkboard very well, but something must not have been right because I brought it up.

Shortly after this, I got my glasses. I remember standing on the deck behind our house with my parents and looking across to the next mountain and seeing houses that I couldn't see before.

My mom, and for that matter my wife, both wear glasses, but they are not nearly nearsighted enough. They both take off their glasses, and then lose them. Not me. I am properly nearsighted – I always wear my glasses. I can't afford to lose them.

Being nearsighted is a part of our human condition – I'm talking metaphorically now, like Jesus after he heals the man born blind in John 9. We view the world from our own small perspective, from one life lived in one time in one place in the world in one particular culture. While some of us have a broader life experience than others – traveling more, reading more, meeting more and varied people, living a larger variety of life's experiences – we are all essentially nearsighted.

During my senior year of college I took a course called "Geography of Wine." (You had to be 21 to fully participate in the course.) I remember that, after the first class, I realized that there was more to learn about this than I ever could have imagined. It is humbling to realize all of the things that we do not know. The world is so full of wonder, beyond our understanding, and other people are


worlds unto themselves that we can never fully know or understand. And when I look at history, the centuries upon centuries stretching back, the countries and cultures that we can only glimpse and get the merest feel for, I realize that there is more to God than I can fathom.

I am nearsighted. We are all nearsighted. We cannot stand upon this earth and think that we have the answers, that we know how God thinks and how God will judge the world. We can only come before God in humility, with some small scraps of faith, with bits of knowledge gleaned from the scriptures, with trust in Jesus who, we believe, shows us a human face for God. We can only rely on the love and grace of God.

When I was in 8th grade, attending Redeemer Lutheran Church (LCMS) in South Charleston, WV, I was confirmed. My pastor gave me a confirmation verse, Micah 6:8. "He has shown you, O mortal, what is good; and what does the Lord require of you but to do justice, and to love kindness, and to walk humbly with your God?"


