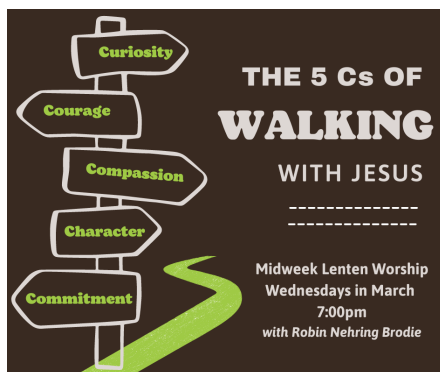

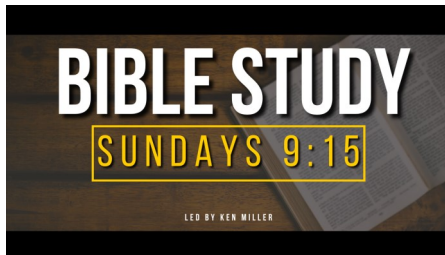


Sunday School News

- Date of Birth
- Home Address

2. The Lutherdale Office will set up and verify account information for each person in your family account.

o If there is more than one household unit registering, each unit will need to register separately.

- Example: Grandma & Grandpa live in Milwaukee, WI. Grandchild #1 lives in Delavan. Grandchild #2

lives in Chicago. Each household will register separately for Grandparent & Grandchild Camp. Grandma & Grandpa will be able to register themselves. They will NOT be able to register Grandchild #1 or #2. Grandchild #1 will be registered by Parent/Guardian #1. Grandchild #2 will be registered by Parent/Guardian #2.

3. Log into your account online and complete registration. Each participant must complete ALL forms to enroll.

4. To be completely registered, full payment is required upon registration.

- o A status of incomplete means you have started the registration process. There is NOT a spot held until full payment is made.
- o All incomplete status registrations will be cleared from your account after 30 days.

Subject: Capital Campaign Kickoff for Pavilion Project Completion

Dear Members in Christ at North Cape Lutheran Church,

The Church Board and Pavilion Committee are excited to kickoff the 2023 "Cover our Congregation" Capital Campaign. We are so close to realizing this vision for our church property. Our goal is to raise a minimum \$75,000 by October 1, 2023. This funding will allow us to complete all four remaining phases of the project. We only need another \$16,636 to complete the building in Phase Two! You may remember two years ago we launched a similar campaign, and due to your generous giving and fundraising programs, we delivered that goal!

Our current plan is to begin building in late summer of 2023 should our fundraising be successful. A large part of this capital campaign will be the launch of a memorial signage program for those who might want to recognize a loved one or a significant life event or donors who provide materials and labor. Please see the attached examples of the signage and how we will update our progress visually in the church narthex. The materials also include a visual of the proposed pavilion sign and explanation of the program. We plan to update you regularly via the website, church communication vehicles and in church visuals as this progresses. All funds from this campaign will be deposited in the Pavilion Fund and used for the multiple phases planned over the next few years.

How can you participate? Weekly giving, Scrip usage, fundraisers, memorial giving, donations of materials or labor, lead a fundraiser, etc. We have three fundraisers that we would like to roll out over the next six months. They are:

- ◆ Kringle Sale
- ◆ Pizza Sale
- ◆ Pasta Dinner

These fundraisers require someone to lead and coordinate them. Last year they delivered over \$12,000 to the project. Please reach out to the committee members if you have interest in leading a fundraiser or have other ideas for us to consider.

Please prayerfully consider how you can support this capital campaign through generous giving, leading or attending fundraisers, or helping us find local partners to help us realize our vision. Donations or work steams like:

- 1) Landscaping materials (trees, labor)
- 2) Spraying or staining of the pavilion after its first year

To date we have already raised over \$110,000 towards this beautiful addition to our outdoor environment. This resource can be used for future weddings, fundraisers, funerals and other family and church gatherings. Thank you for your ongoing generosity and support of our mission to grow committed followers of Jesus Christ.
