Early Easter

It's been 8 years since we've had a March Easter. March Easters show up occasionally, usually once every 4 or 5 or 8 years or so. Most of us have experienced it being on March 23rd – back in 2008. (I'm thinking that may have been the year we have a picture of our boys and our nieces hunting for Easter eggs in the snow.)

We have also experienced Easters in late April, like in 2011 when it fell on April 24th . (There could have been snow that day also, but it's a bit less likely.) For various reasons, the date of Easter is based on when the full moon falls in relation to the Spring equinox. Easter falls on the first Sunday after the first full moon after the equinox, which is on, or about, March 21st .

However, I'm looking at it a little differently right now. Maybe Easter is showing up in March because, somehow, we are in need of Easter.

Easter has been looking at our world, at all of

us who are in it, and at all of the situations we have gotten ourselves into. Easter looked down and saw the wars and the viruses. Easter got wind of our polarities, our divisions, our struggles, and complaints. Easter took a good long look at the state of things and decided that we are in need of some hope and some relief.

So Easter marshalled the forces – sent the clouds to cover the sky on February 2nd so that the groundhog would miss his shadow and spring would be ordered up early – checked in with the Moon and arranged for her fullness to arrive with the worms on March 25th – as Easter still prepares to arise on wings with Alleluias and lilies and the rosy fingered dawn along with all the glory of the Sun on March 31st, bringing with it joy and hope and singing, the promise of new life, and the end of death.

Easter is having mercy on us, arriving early so that we can be fed with hope and feel joy. So that our lives can be renewed.

Show your appreciation to Easter and pay attention. Prepare for Easter through prayer and worship, through remembering our need for God and God's mercy and strength and goodness in our lives, through remembering Jesus – not just his resurrection, but his rejection and death out of love for all of us, to show us how to live and how to love one another. And then out of the despair of Good Friday, and the darkness of Holy Saturday, celebrate the new life given to us on Easter Day – just a bit earlier than usual.
