When we need to remind ourselves of God's faithfulness, it is often life's challenges that we look back upon to give us the hope and strength to make it through our current situations.

And so it is now. I have both anxiety and eagerness in leaving North Cape to serve Trinity, but I also remember how God has led me in the past, from congregation to congregation, and how I have been blessed in working with the members of each congregation I have served.

Likewise, you can look back and see how God has called pastors to serve here and have hope that God is at work for you as well.

We are not a people of certainty. We are a people of hope. We are not promised that everything will always be easy or go according to our plans. We are promised that God will stay with us through all of life's blessings and turmoils.

More than I can tell you, I have been blessed in serving as your interim pastor, and for that I give thanks both to God and to you all. Now, I am looking forward in hope to the next place God has called me, confident that I will find there the same people I have found in North Cape and the other congregations I have served – the people of God.

Meeting called to order by President, Les Gumieny

Worship Update

- Pastor Robb submitted his letter of resignation. After dealing with the initial shock, Council thanked Pastor Robb for his 2.5 years of service as Interim Pastor. November 30th will be his last Sunday at NCLC.
- Pastor Robb and Ann Henderson will be recognized jointly on November 30th.
- On Sunday December 7th Robin Brodie will lead the NCLC 8am service. However, she cannot remain for the 10:30 service. Therefore, we are looking for a volunteer to lead the 10:30 service.
- There will be no communion on December 7th.
- There will only be one service on December 28, 2025.

Sound System Update

The sound system is currently being installed. The AV fund raising goal has been exceeded. The Sound System raffle will buy additional microphones and excess money will be donated to the General Fund.

Budget Update

- The Executive Committee will meet Tuesday, November 18th at 6:30 to review the 2026 Budget.

Financials

NCLC has had a very successful Sound System Campaign and our 2025 General Fund Giving exceeds our 2024 General Fund Giving by \$17,348. However, as of October 31 our 2025 General Fund Expenses have exceeded our 2025 Giving by \$57,068. Hopefully this shortfall will be rectified with our year end giving.



The crew (Jake, Jonathon, Kurt & Don) worked so hard Monday through Friday, cleaned up after themselves, & answered every stupid question I had every day! Jake & Jonathon spent a couple hours with a handful of us to learn the new system &

even communicated with me after my frantic call for help on Sunday morning!

We have raised \$300 more than needed for the original project. That money along with the dollars raised from the raffle tickets will pay for the new computer & monitor we needed to purchase for the balcony (we need another \$500).
