So, now I'm stuck trying to come up with a way to say what I want to say without all of the dumb parts, and to do it without Ann noticing that I've missed the newsletter deadline, yet again.

#### Basically, it's this:

- Our lives are not our own.
- Our lives belong to God, the God whom we know through Jesus Christ.
