A Spirit of Playfulness

Due to illness, Pastor Robb's wife, Pastor Lisa Nelson, has provided this month article. Thank you, Pastor Lisa!

What does summer in Wisconsin mean to you? For many, it means playing. School is out, and it's time for cabins at the lake and vacations and relaxing and having fun. However, many people have to work, so that leaves the weekends for play. That makes sense. In fact, God invented play. God created all that is in a spirit of playfulness.

At least according to Proverbs 8:22-31. The speaker in this chapter is personified as a woman and called Wisdom. She says, "I was there <u>before</u> God created the heavens and the earth. I was at God's side as God stretched the skies over the earth and gave the seas their limits, as God carved a way for the rivers and filled the lakes with water."

And what was it like for Wisdom? She says, "It was delightful! I played in God's creation, in the waves of the ocean and on the shores of the lakes. I delighted in everything, especially <u>in all of</u> humankind." Wisdom looks at humanity in all its diversity and says, "Yes! Yes, I love this!"

And since this is the Wisdom of God, we know that God feels the same way, that God creates with joy, that play is built into the DNA of creation. Wisdom's playfulness is a statement about God: God created play as holy.

And if Wisdom is playful, curious, creative, and deeply connected to creation, then following Wisdom means following in her footsteps. What can you be curious about? Who can you connect with? Where is play in your life? This doesn't mean we have to be happy all the time, but it does mean saying yes to wonder and diversity and delight in each other.

As you play this summer think about this—and think about North Cape Lutheran. How can you continue to take care of your congregation, prayerfully and financially? How can we weave playfulness into the future of this congregation? That gives us lots to think about this summer and as we head into fall.

May we open ourselves to joy and listen to Wisdom's voice. And may we find laughter and wonder as we connect with God's creation and humanity.

#### **Consent Agenda and June Minutes Approved**

#### **Worship Update**

Pastor was unable to attend this Council meeting due to illness. Rally Sunday will be September 7, 2025.

#### Community Picnic/175th Anniversary Plans/discussion

September 13th will be the final cookout/175th anniversary picnic date.

We will have a grilled picnic dinner. Dinner plans will be finalized at the September Council meeting. WELCA will provide 2 cakes, one for the Saturday picnic and the second for Sunday church services. Newspaper notification is in process.
