Financial Updates

We are thankful to our members that our offerings this year have grown from last year. We are still behind on fully supporting the ministry God has called us to at North Cape.

Our August expenses included \$9,515 to support ELCA World Hunger, Lutheran Social Services, Lutheran World Relief, our mission in EL Salvador, Lutherdale Bible Camp, the Union Grove Food Bank, and the Greater Milwaukee Synod. With our offerings, we not only support our own congregation, but the work of God beyond ourselves.

Below, you will see our offerings and expenses for July and August.

If you have not done so this year, please consider how you may be able to grow in your offerings to North Cape and the ministry of our Congregation.

Intentional, planned, regular, and generous offerings will make all the difference for North Cape this year. According to our annual Ministry Plan, our expenses average nearly \$6,300 per week. Thank you.


