Nearing The Finish Line

For a variety of reasons calling a new pastor takes a lot longer than used to. It can feel like the congregation is running a marathon, especially for the Council and Call Committee. Using this metaphor I arrived around mile marker 25. You had already had a long interim with Pastor Robb, had already done the MET process, had already finished your MSP, had already formed a Call Committee, had already interviewed some candidates, and had scheduled a second interview with the woman who will become your next pastor.

The call vote is mile marker 26. Pastor Kelly is officially your next pastor. You should be proud of all the hard work and prayer that has gotten you this far. Many of you have stepped up in a variety of ways during this extended transition to keep

things running smoothly.

We are now in that last .2 miles of this marathon call process. You know Pastor Kelly will be your next pastor BUT she won't be coming until after Easter. I have never personally run a marathon and it is decidedly NOT on my bucket list, but I have to imagine that a runner would be both exhausted by the many miles of running behind them and excited to see the finish line finally visible ahead.

I want to encourage you to lean into that excitement. North Cape Lutheran Church has faithfully served its community for over 175 years but 2026 will be the first year with Pastor Kelly. She will get to experience her first Golf Outing, her first Youth Mission Trip, her first Community Cook Out in the pavilion, her first Ice Fishing & Meat Raffle, and so many other firsts.

Just as Pastor Kelly will be experiencing firsts with you, I encourage you to be open to the new firsts Pastor Kelly will invite you to do. She will come with fresh eyes, new ideas, and novel ways of doing familiar things. The marathon of pastoral transition may be almost over but it is also just the beginning.

Meeting called to order by President, Les Gumienny

Introduction of New Council Members

Paul Steiner introduced himself. He needed little introduction as Paul had served on the Call Committee for Pastor Kelly Ylitalo. Laura Sabo was not present.

Appointment of Executive Council

This item was tabled until the March meeting

Review Annual Meeting

The Congregation voted to call the Pastor Kelly Ylitalo. Pastor Ylitalo accepted our call to be the Pastor at North Cape Lutheran Church. We are in the process of setting her official start date and the logistics of her physical move to North Cape from Michigan's Upper Peninsula. Her start date has not yet been finalized but it will be soon after Easter.

It was clearly heard at the Annual Meeting members want greater visibility of the church financial records, especially the Youth Mission Fund, the El Salvador Mission Fund, and the Golf Outing. Therefore, on March 1, 2026 the Council will make available print outs of the 2025 financial documents to our members who are interested in these documents. The four documents will be in four piles, by the welcome center. The four documents will be the Statement of Activity January – December 2025, and the 2025 Statement of Activities for El Salvador Missions, the Golf Outing, and the Mission Trip. Due to the cost associated with this undertaking, at the bottom of each document pile will be a signup sheet. Please add your name to the signup sheet if the available printed copies have been exhausted and we will provide you with a copy of your requested document. In future years these documents will be in the Annual Report so as not to cause this additional expense. But, because the transparency of this information is critical, we are making the effort to supply the Congregation with the 2025 information.

Point Number 1. We are supplying the Congregation with the official 2025 church accounting records. These records were compiled in good faith by people who have accepted the responsibility of tracking the Congregation's donations and paying its expenses. To evaluate any possible additions or deletions to these records specific items must be presented to the Council on an item-by-item basis, in writing, and complete with the appropriate, dated, supporting documentation.

Point Number 2.

For purposes of constructing the Budget, Mission Giving line items will total 10% of the Budget Prior to Mission Giving. Each Mission Giving line item has a percentage assigned to it so the total Mission Giving percentage is 10%. However, Actual Mission Giving expenses will be 10% of the Actual General Expense income and may therefore be more or less than the amount indicated in the Budget. Because the 2025 Actual General Expense income was less than the Budgeted amount the actual 2025 paid Mission Giving Expenses were less than the Budgeted 2025 amount. This Mission Giving procedure was voted on and approved by Council at it February 12, 2025 meeting. See attached.

Our 2026 January General Fund Income was \$15,932. In January 2026 the Mission Trip raised \$21,529. Our 2026 January General Fund Expenses were \$14,535.

Consent Agenda Approved

Worship Update

Wednesday, March 5, 2025 is Ash Wednesday. We will have Lenten Suppers hosted by various groups within the Congregation. Council is hosting the first Lenten Supper on March 12, 2025. Our menu and duties were discussed and delegated.

Two year-end exiting Council members volunteered to serve on the nominating committee, Amy Stillson and Jake Hoffmann. Current nominating team members are Paula Jaspersen and Linda Hyde.

Financials

- January 2025 Revenue was \$29,994. However, the Youth Ministry income due to the January Fish Jamboree accounted for \$17,824 of the revenue. January 2025 Expenses were \$23,865. January Expenses consisted of predominantly payroll expenses.
- The Council voted and approved the following Mission Giving Proposal.
"For Purposes of constructing the Budget, Mission Giving line items will total 10% of the Budget prior to Mission Giving. Each Mission Giving line item has a percentage assigned to it so the total Mission Giving percentage is 10%. Actual Mission Giving expenses will be 10% of the actual income to General Expenses and may therefore be more or less than the amount indicated in the budget. NCLC church member designated congregational offerings for any Mission Giving line item will go toward the amount indicated in the budget. The NCLC annual actual paid amounts to each individual Mission Giving line item will not exceed the amount determined by multiplying the assigned line-item percentage by the actual income to General Expenses. Donations made to the El Salvador Missions Fund will be deposited directly into the El Salvador Missions Fund and not into the General Fund. Monies raised in fund raisers will also be deposited into their designated funds."
