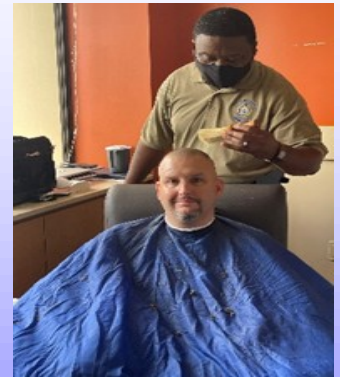
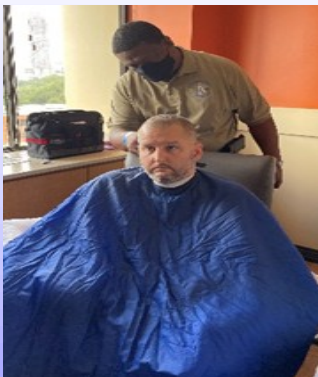
Doing More With Lodge 64

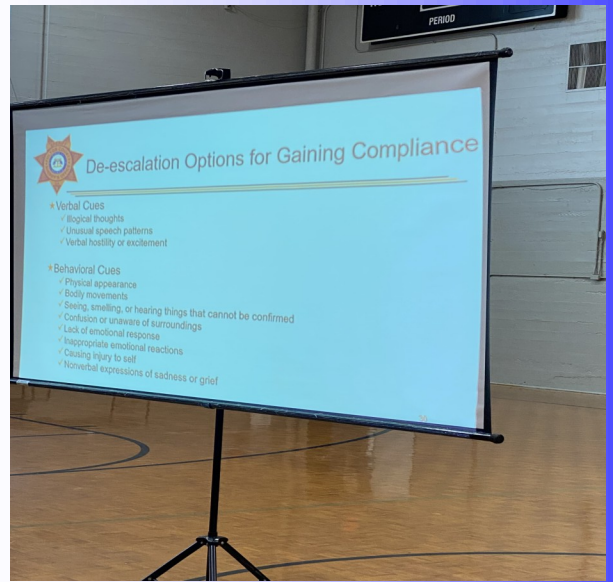

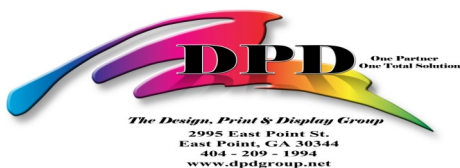
