







Knowledge is power



- 1. Water 1 gallon per person 3-day supply for evacuation, 2-week supply for home
- 2. Food non-perishable easy to prepare 3-day supply
- Can opener
- 4. Medical items & medication 1 month supply
- 5. Sanitation & personal hygiene item
- 6. First Aid kit
- 7. Masks, soap, hand sanitizer, disinfecting wipes
