INTRODUCTION

Thank you for your enquiry. Haakdoorn Academy is a small independent school situated in the Haakdoornboom area, close to Soshanguve. Our language of instruction is English, and Afrikaans is our additional language. Since our teacher/learner ratio is low, learners receive a lot of individual attention and can reach their full potential academically. Our curriculum is CAPS aligned and we use a range of learning and support material to help learners grasp concepts and complex subject matter. We follow the same calendar as government schools, and we are closed during all school and public holidays. We open at 6:30 in the mornings and learners attend class from 7:20 until 14:00 from Mondays to Thursdays and 13:00 on Fridays. Below is a summary of our fees for 2023.

The application fee is payable when you submit the application form. The fee payable for your child's books is due by 30 November 2022, and the fee for the stationery, by 31 December 2022. The stationery box is collected the day before school reopens as the items must be marked individually.

The annual fee is payable over twelve (12) equal installments, from 1 January to 1 December. The installments are **strictly payable in advance** on the 1st day of every calendar month and the 1st installment for 2023 is due on 1 January 2023. The final installment for the year is due on 1 December 2023. If the annual fee is paid in full before 31 January 2023, you qualify for R1 000 discount.
