Schmid died Thursday in a Denver, Colo., nursing home. He had resided in Denver the past three and a half years.

Schmid was born in Holdingford, Minn., June 20, 1890, the eldest of 13 children born to Mr. and Mrs. Frank Schmid Sr., who later made their home in Avon, Minn.

Schmid married Catherine E. Thome Oct. 22, 1912. He was engaged in business in Little Falls, Minn., and later went into the banking business in Browerville, Minn., Sidney, Mont., and Castlewood and Dallas in South Dakota.

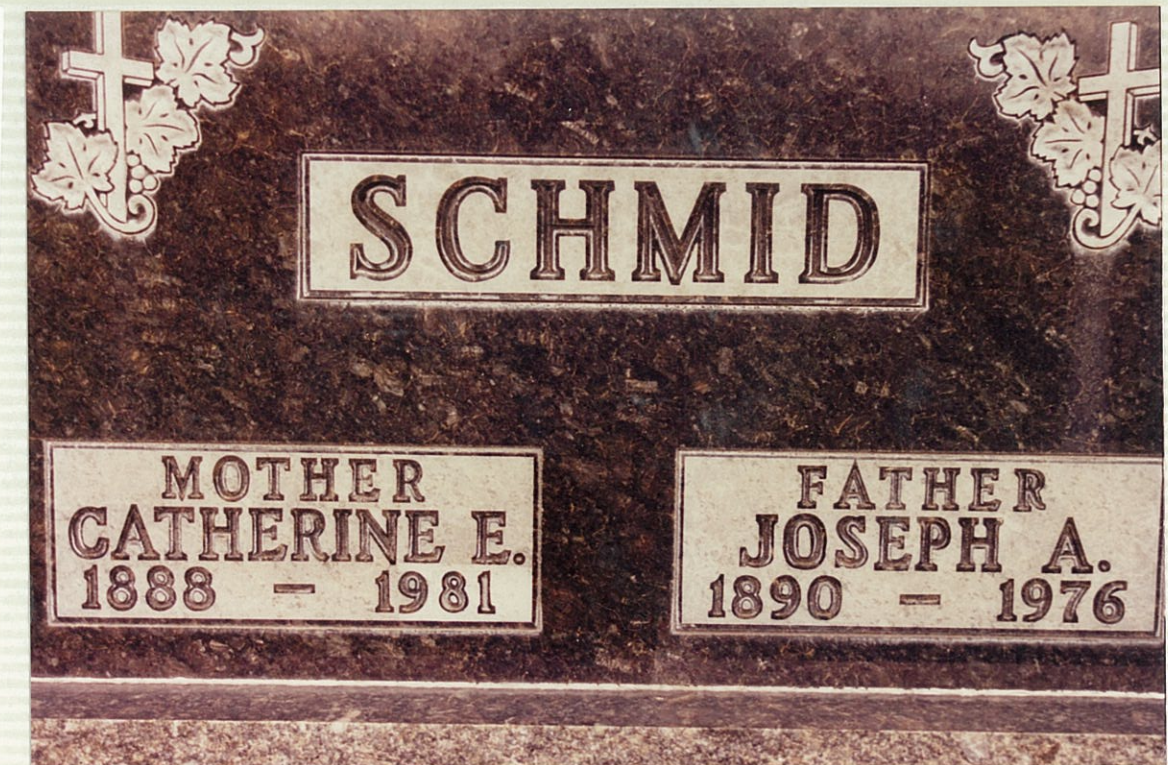
While in Dallas he accepted a position as a state bank examiner. He moved to Rapid City in 1931 and started the National Finance and Investment Co., and later the Schmid Insurance Agency which his two younger sons continue to operate.

Schmid is survived by his wife Catherine, Denver; five sons, Bernard, Silver Spring, Md.; Col. retired Air Force Col. Edwin P., San Antonio, Tex.; Leonard, Brownsburg, Ind., and George and Francis, Rapid City; two daughters, Viola, Rancho Palo Verde, Calif., and Mrs. Robert N. (Mildred) Fenton, Denver; four brothers, George, Avon, Minn.; Harry, Dent, Minn.; Leo, Folsom, Calif., and Aloysisus, St. Paul, Minn.; one sister, Mrs. Gertrude Welle, San Juan Capistrano, Calif.; 25 grandchildren and 28 great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by four brothers and three sisters.

Schmid was a life member of the Knights of Columbus and the Elks, and former past member of Our Lady Perpetual Help Cathedral. At the time of his death he was a member of Most Precious Blood Catholic Church in Denver.

A memorial has been established for Catholic charities.

A memorial has been established.

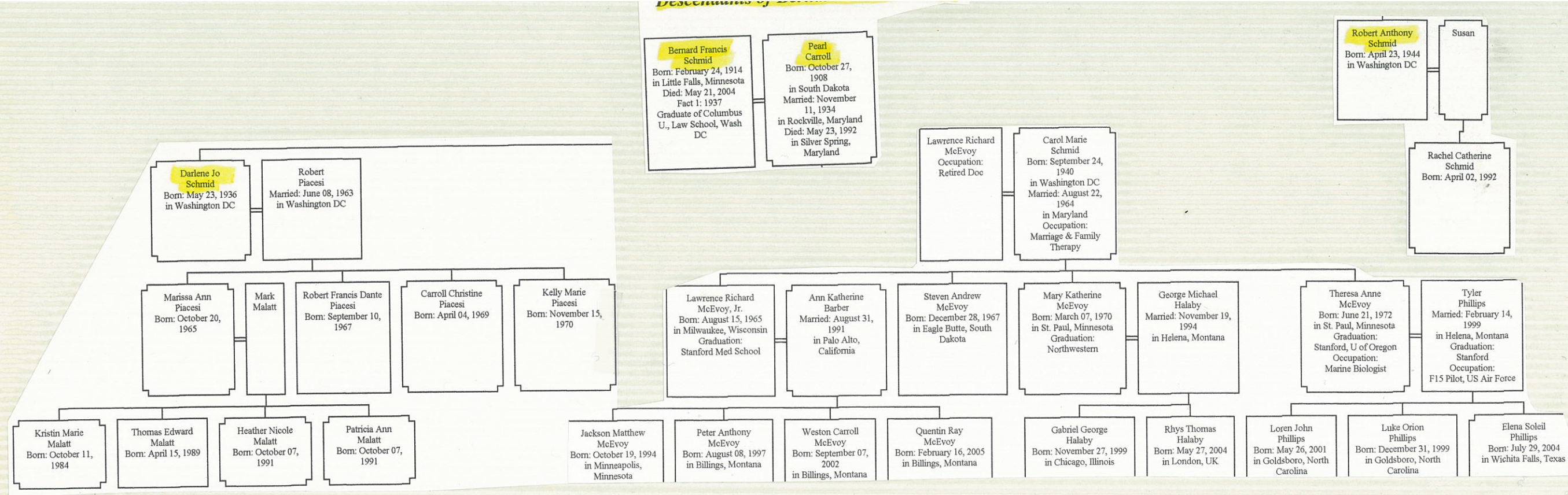
Mrs. Schmid, the former Catherine Thome, died Thursday at a Denver nursing home. She was born July 23, 1888, at Avon, Minn.

She married Joseph A. Schmid Oct. 22, 1912. They lived in Rapid City from 1931 until June 1972 when they moved to Denver.

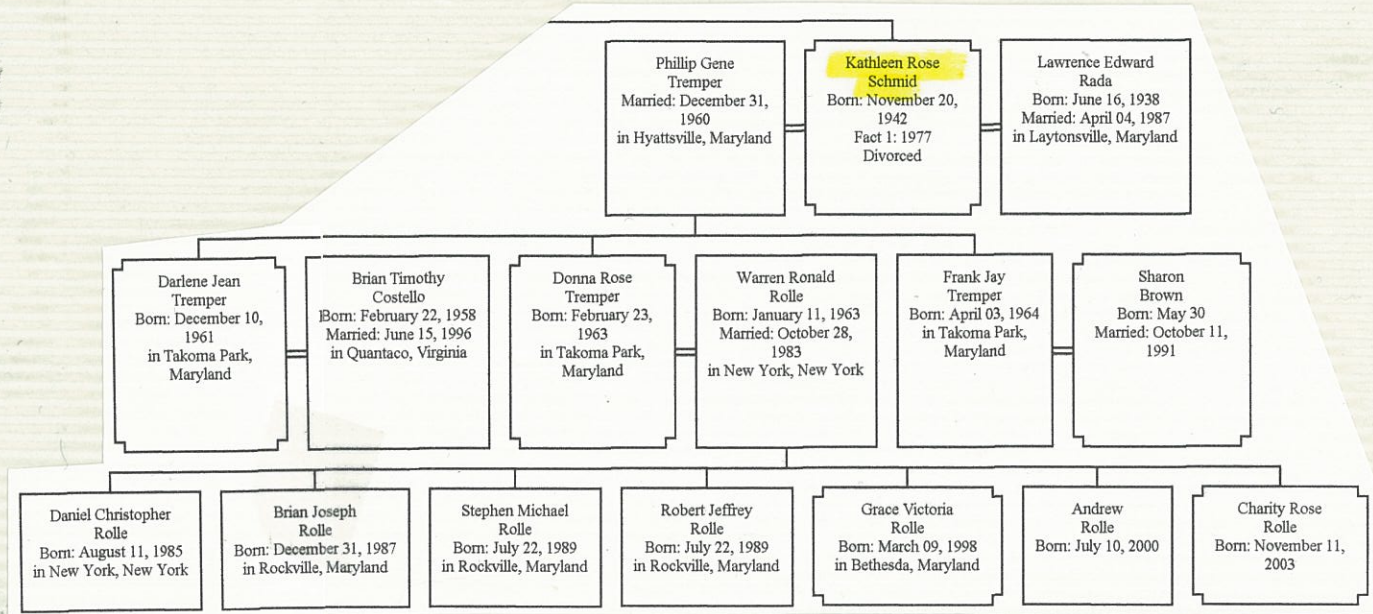
Mrs. Schmid was a member of the Catholic Daughters of America and the International Order of Foresters.

Edwin P. Schmid

BOERNE, Texas — Services for former Rapid City resident Col. Edwin P. Schmid, who was killed in a tractor accident at his home in Boerne March 30, are pending at Fort Sam Houston Military Base in San Antonio, Texas.

He was born Sept. 14, 1915, in Little Falls, Minn., to Joseph and Catherine Schmid. He moved with his parents to Rapid City in August 1931, where he attended high school.

He attended the South Dakota School of Mines & Technology and Creighton University, each for a year before being appointed by Congressman T.B. Werner to the U.S. Military Academy at West Point in 1935.

After graduation, he attended Kelly Field for basic training and advanced flight training. He then went to Command and General Staff School at Fort Leavenworth, Kan., and Air Staff School in Washington, D.C.

During World War II, he was group commander in the 376th heavy bombardment group and led a group of B-24 bombers on a low-level raid over Romania. He was awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross with clusters, the Air Medal with four clusters, the Silver Star and the Croix de Guerre from France.

He retired in January 1966 as base commander at Tinker AFB, Okla., and moved to a small ranch near Boerne, where he lived until his death.

He is survived by his wife, Doris of Boerne; two daughters, Toni Schmid and Mimi Rissinger, both of Austin, Texas; three brothers, George of Rapid City, Leonard of Hartwell, Ga., and Bernard of Silver Springs, Md.; two sisters, Mildred Fenton of Denver, and Viola Schmid of Laguna Hills, Calif.

He was preceded in death by a brother.
