Over time the years decrease, however, an extension of 90 years, can be added to the existing remaining term of the lease. The bird of the month is "The Great spotted Woodpecker".


Habitat:- They are likely to be found anywhere there are trees. Some live in parks and large gardens in urban areas. They may even visit bird tables and hanging feeders.
