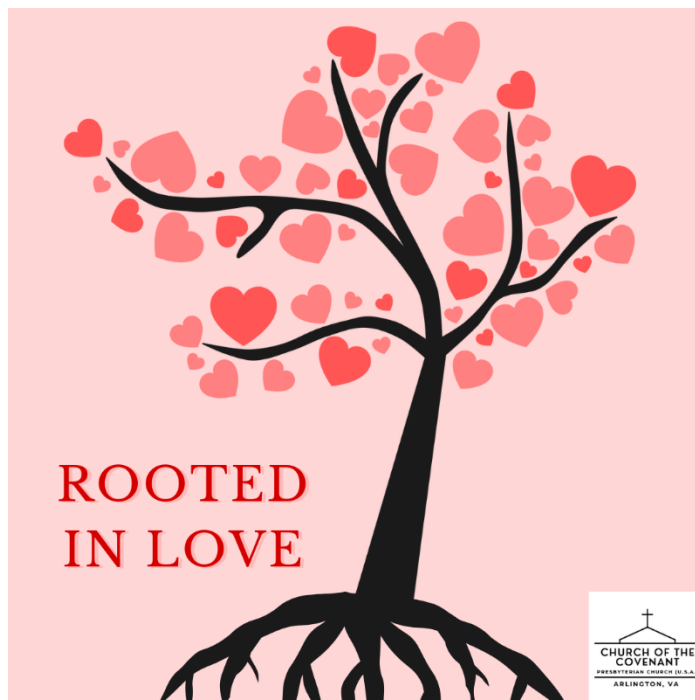

Pivotal Moments in Isaiah, Chapters 10-26

In February, the Isaiah study will continue with pivotal moments in the prophecies of First Isaiah, as God's messenger advises the King of Judah on being faithful and trusting in the Lord to protect the people from the encroaching Assyrian Empire. On February 10, we'll begin with chapter 10, completing a series of Judgment-Promise patterns that culminates in chapter 11's promise of a "shoot from the stump of Jesse, and a branch shall grow from its roots." (Isaiah 11:1) If you are unable to meet at 10 am on Tuesday mornings, the sessions are being recorded and stored on a Google drive for up to 2 weeks. Easter Lilies



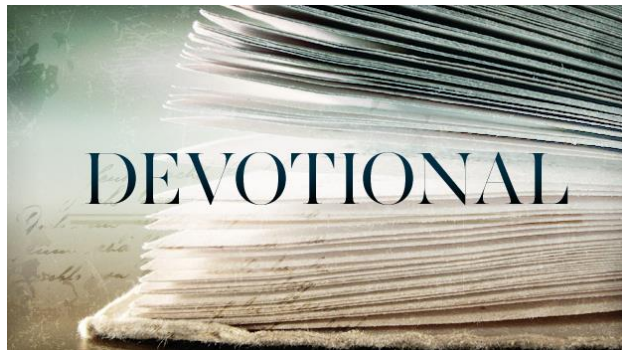
