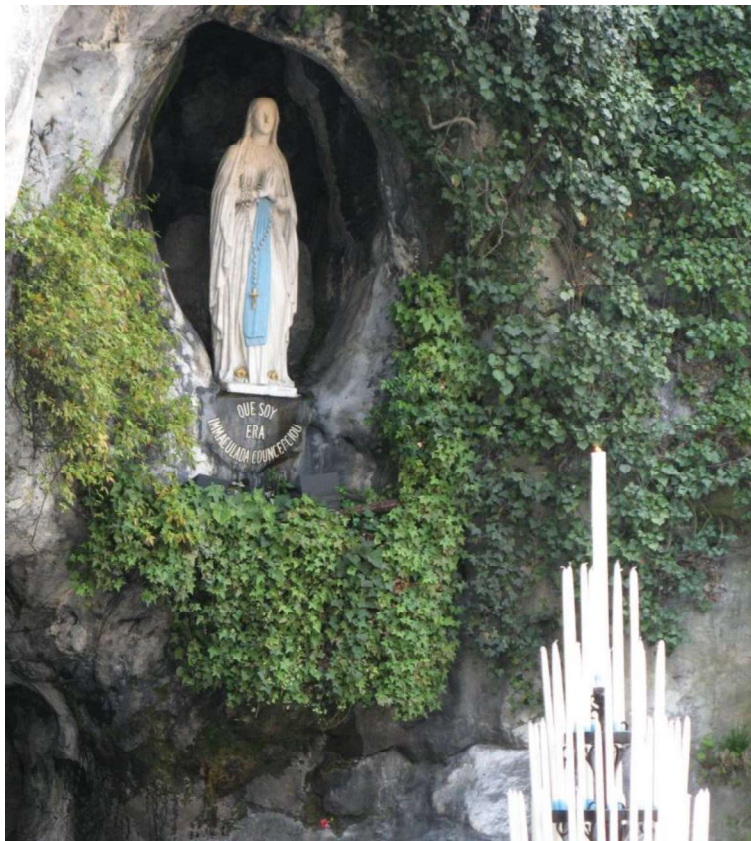

Day 1: Sunday, February 21, 2027 Overnight Flight

Travel overnight to Portugal, one of Europe's most hospitable countries. Here, you can enjoy a superb climate, historic sites, and beautiful scenery.

Day 2: Monday, February 22, 2027 Fatima, Portugal

Arrive in Fatima, Portugal's world-famous religious center. With no scheduled sightseeing today, spend the day as you wish, exploring the city independently. You may want to join the candlelight procession tonight.** (D)

Day 3: Tuesday, February 23, 2027 Fatima - Aljustrel -

Fatima You may celebrate Mass* before traveling to Aljustrel, the quaint village of the three shepherd children to whom Our Lady appeared. Here, you can visit their humble homes and immerse yourself in the serene atmosphere of their daily lives. Continue to Valinhos, the site of the fifth apparition, where you can reflect on the profound events that took place. Later, return to Fatima** to enjoy free time for personal worship and to explore the basilica and its grounds. You may want to join an optional experience to return to the centuries-old capital of Lisbon. (B, D)

Day 4: Wednesday, February 24, 2027 Fatima -

Burgos, Spain Attend a morning Mass* before traveling along the long Pilgrim's Road to arrive in Burgos later this afternoon, a city that gracefully straddles the banks of the Rio Arlanzon. The slender, elegant spires of its famous cathedral rise majestically into the sky, a testament to its rich history and architectural splendor. In the evening, you may have the opportunity to attend another Mass,* allowing for further reflection and spiritual enrichment. (B)

Day 5: Thursday, February 25, 2027 Burgos

Join a local expert on a walking tour of Burgos' medieval town center. Spend time at Burgos Cathedral, a masterpiece of Spanish Gothic architecture and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The cathedral, the third largest in Spain, offers such masterpieces as the filigree work in the spires of the towers, the starry dome, the choir, the sarcophagi, and the golden staircase. Next, visit a monastery and learn about monastic life and architecture. Mass* is available this evening. (B, L)

Day 6: Friday, February 26, 2027 Burgos - Lourdes,

France Today, travel northeast through the Pyrenees mountains to Lourdes. This is where the Virgin Mary appeared in the Grotto of Massabielle to the poor shepherd girl Bernadette a total of 18 times between February 11 and July 16, 1858. Since then, this little market town has been a world-renowned pilgrimage site. Tonight you may wish to partake in a candlelight procession.** (B, D)

Day 7: Saturday, February 27, 2027 Lourdes After morning Mass,* enjoy a walking tour of Lourdes, visiting the places associated with the life of St. Bernadette: the "Boly Mill" (the site of her birthplace), the "Cachot" (the former prison where she and her family lived), and the parish church housing the saint's baptismal font. Later, enjoy some time at leisure to explore the town's rich historical and natural heritage. Become immersed in the atmosphere of the time of the apparitions and revel in the spirit of brotherhood that is still present today. (B, D)

Day 8: Sunday, February 28, 2027 Lourdes - Barcelona, Spain Celebrate Mass* before crossing back into Spain on your way to Barcelona, one of Europe's most fascinating cities. Prepare yourself for a long journey through Spain's beautiful scenery. Upon arrival, get your first taste of this vibrant city with a walk around the area of your hotel. (B)

Day 9: Monday, March 1, 2027 Barcelona Get to know Barcelona with a panoramic tour showcasing the Columbus Monument and Parc de Montjuic, which offers breathtaking views of the city. Continue the morning exploring the narrow streets of the Gothic Quarter with your local guide, and discover the Barcelona Cathedral, a Gothic masterpiece in the heart of the city. Spend this afternoon at leisure exploring the city further or you may choose an optional** excursion to the quaint mountain village of Montserrat. This evening, gather with your fellow travelers for a dinner celebrating the end of a memorable tour. (B, D)

Day 10: Tuesday, March 2, 2027 Barcelona - Tour Ends Return home eager to share vivid memories of a beautiful land with an old, rich, and diverse cultural heritage. (B)

Experience It! Burgos, Land of Cathedrals

Burgos was founded in 884 AD and its historical heritage is immediately evident. Its main sites are ecclesiastical, most notably its cathedral, but it has an atmosphere of rare grandeur. Burgos Cathedral, begun in 1221 and completed in 1567, is among the most admired in the world. Especially remarkable is its south portal, the "Puerta del Sarmental," considered the best example of Gothic sculpture of its century. The cathedral is modeled after Bourges Cathedral in France and reflects the Gothic style made popular in Spain by the Cistercian Order.

Important Tour Information:

The overall activity level of this tour is a level 2. This means you like a balanced approach to travel. Walking two to three miles over the course of a day is no problem for you. You can handle a variety of terrains, from cobblestone streets to moderate hills with relative ease and without assistance. You can climb two flights of stairs with ease. Expect some full days balanced with free time to recharge or set out on your own adventure. You can handle altitudes up to 6,000 feet. While this level is appropriate for travelers that require mobility assistance devices, there could be times when you may have to sit out on some of the included activities.

Travel with an average of 37 people (maximum of 44).

During our Barcelona walking tour in the Gothic Quarter, expect to walk around 1 mile on cobblestone streets and uphill at times.

If you require any special assistance while on tour, please make us aware at time of reservation so the necessary request form can be sent to your attention.

We are visiting medieval towns with steep, uneven, cobblestone ground, and stairs and steps are everywhere.

As this tour travels to 3 countries, expect 3 days of long bus transfers.

****In Fatima and Lourdes, there is a candlelight procession every night at 9:00 p.m. or 9:30 p.m. from April to November.**

*Mass is subject to availability and may not be offered in English.

****The optional tour Montserrat must be booked at least 60 days prior to departure and is not guaranteed while on tour.**

Breakfasts in Lourdes are Continental.

Single accommodations are limited and are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Single rate subject to change based on availability.

Due to traffic regulations, buses cannot reach historic city centers. This means at times, the bus may drop the group off at one location but pick it up elsewhere. If you opt out of an activity, you'll need to arrange your own transfer to the next bus pick-up spot, as travelers cannot remain on the bus during stops due to European regulations.

To complete your tour, we include round-trip airport-to-hotel transfers when purchasing our airfare with your tour. If you have arranged for your own air, we are pleased to provide you the option of *purchasing* these transfers. Please note that all transfers will leave at pre-scheduled times.

Our transfers will depart from Lisbon airport for Fatima. Travel time from Lisbon to Fatima is approximately 2 hours.

Our air travelers will arrive into Lisbon, Portugal airport.

For air-inclusive reservations, the name provided at time of booking must match your government-issued ID that will be used during travel. Name changes are subject to penalties.

Please be advised, many airlines do not provide advance seat assignments until check-in at the airport. Advance seating will be subject to the airline's terms and conditions.

Due to tour scheduling, arrival flights should arrive prior to 2:00 p.m.

Prepaid tipping is not available on our tours therefore payment of customary end-of-trip gratuities for your Tour Manager, driver, local guides, hotel housekeepers, and cruise ship waitstaff should be handled individually when applicable during the course of your tour.



Economy air rate and schedule are applicable for groups of 10 or more traveling on the same flights and dates.

Travel Requirements:

Passports are required for this tour at your expense. Certain countries require that your passport be valid at least 6 months beyond the dates of your travel. You are strongly urged to contact the appropriate consulate for details. Visit www.travel.state.gov for the U.S. State Department for the latest details about passports and visa requirements.

IMPORTANT: We recommend that travelers take a photocopy of their passport and applicable visas. It should be packed separately from your actual passport and visa. We also recommend leaving a copy at home with your emergency contact.

Collette will provide all necessary information, updates and supporting documents for your travel requirements, including visa and Electronic Travel Authorizations (ETAs), approximately 60-90 days prior to your departure.

ETIAS visa waiver requirements are anticipated to begin during the last quarter of 2026, for a fee, when visiting a Schengen Area Country. To identify Schengen Area Countries and to complete the ETIAS application, please visit https://travel-europe.europa.eu/etias_en

A deposit of \$698 per person is due upon reservation. Reservations are made on a first come, first served basis. Reservations made after the seat reduction date of August 15, 2026 are based upon availability. Final payment due by November 23, 2026. Deposits are refundable up until August 22, 2026.
