This scholarship is sponsored by the Antwerp Conservation Club. Any graduating senior who plans to enter a college or university and pursue a degree may apply. You must be admitted to qualify.

Graduating seniors with a minimum GPA of 2.75 from the following schools: Antwerp, Fairview, Hicksville, Paulding, Wayne Trace and Woodlan may apply. These students can be home-schooled or attend a conventional accredited high school.

Purpose of the Antwerp Conservation Club:
