I respectfully request the Monterey County District Attorney's Office Investigate Mayor Kimbely Craig for possible Conflict of Interest violations.

July 2017 Kimbley Craig was hired as President and CEO of Monterey Bay Business Council During part of her employment she was a city council member and Mayor of Salinas. Starting in 8/10/2017 the city sponsored MCBC aswell as agreed to continue membership in MCBC

The Salinas United Business Association (SUBA) is a community-driven business association and its ability to collect assessments is approved by the Salinas City Council. The Salnas United Business Association (SUBA) has had contracts with Monterey County Business Council. At this point they have not provided the contracts- See Email Exchange with Alejandro Chavez of SUBA

SUBA has been on City council Agenda approximately 9-14 times while Kimbley Craig was on council. She has recused herself only once from the vote to approve SUBA.

The Warrants/ expenditures presented and approved for expenditures for the Monterey County Business Council were voted on and approved by Kimbley Craig.

According to information available to me It appears Kimbley Craig Violated Conflict of Interest Rules. Monterey County Business Council has provided services to Salinas and SUBA. Some of which do not appear to have been bid on.

Conflicts of Interest Rules

Under the Act, a public official has a disqualifying conflict of interest in a governmental decision if it is foreseeable that the decision will have a financial impact on his or her personal finances or other financial interests. In such cases, there is a risk of biased decision-making that could sacrifice the public's interest in favor of the official's private financial interests. To avoid actual bias or the appearance of possible improprieties, the public official is prohibited from participating in the decision.

Disqualifying Financial Interests

There are five types of interests that may result in disqualification:

Business Entity. A business entity in which the official has an investment of \$2,000 or more in which he or she is a director, officer, partner, trustee, employee, or manager.

Bids on, or enters into, a contract with the agency, or is identified as a subcontractor on a bid or contract with the agency;

Councilmember Sandoval:

I apologize, but I may require more information to answer your question fully/correctly.

According to staff, the only payments the City has remitted to the Monterey County Business Council over the past two fiscal years are the two referenced below. Therefore, unless the membership included/includes a ticket for an event or the payment for a ticket was remitted to another payee, we can not confirm whether the City Manager received a ticket and/or whether the City paid for one for him. I should note, however, that although other than what its name suggests, I am unaware of what MCBC's purpose, I know organizations often hold informational events which occur during, &/or span, a typical meal period, so they often provide attendees meals (for which, of course, there is a cost). As another example, training events and conferences often occur over several days, and meals are provided. And while sponsors of events, as in the case of conferences, often pay the costs of some of the meals (directly or indirectly through sponsorships), it is not unusual for registration fees to include the cost of directly or indirectly through sponsorships), it is not unusual for registration fees to include the cost of meals, which one would expect, given attendees are, essentially, a "captive" audience.

I hope this answers your question or at least provides some context to address your concern. But if it does not, if you provide more detail as to what, specifically, I should look for, I will research further.
