September 20-26 is National Adult Education and Family Literacy Week. This is when we participate in raising public awareness about the need for and value of adult education and family literacy. Its goal is to highlight resources that support access to basic education programs for the 36 million U.S. adults with low literacy skills. We use this opportunity to promote adult education and family literacy nationwide with policymakers, the media, and the community.

This year, the Del Norte County Library would like to celebrate the success of the work they are doing through Career Online High School. This is a partnership with the California State Library and Gale, part of Cengage Learning; through this, adults are offered the opportunity to earn an accredited high school diploma and career certificate online.

Career Online High School through Del Norte Reads at the Del Norte County Library is open to residents of Del Norte County. Applicants who successfully complete an online self-assessment and prerequisite course, followed by an in-person interview, will be considered for enrollment.

Once enrolled in the program, Career Online High School pairs each student with an online academic coach, who provides the student with an individual career path, offers ongoing guidance, evaluates performance and connects the student with the resources needed to master the courses. Students will be given up to 18 months to complete the program.
