The meeting was called to order at 7:00pm and the board was thanked for their attendance and service.

- Agenda Item 1: Review of June minutes
 - Discussion: Motion to accept June minutes by Liz Martin-Taylor and seconded by Mike Muir. Approved by all.
 - Action/Results: Minutes will be on the USWRCA website.
- Agenda Item 2: Financial Report- Stephanie Sandberg
 - Discussion: Monthly Report – Checking: \$28,720.03 Savings: \$25
 - Motion to accept report by Tara Thurgood and seconded by Mike Muir, approved by all.
- Agenda Item 3: Stewards Meeting – Ron Brinkerhoff
 - Make sure your members know the rules
 - Give riders the benefit if you aren't sure
 - Help members out – if you see something that isn't correct, help the member out and let them know before they go into the event.
 - The starting lines are 30 feet apart, except single barrels and 5-in-a-row which are 20 feet off the fence.
 - Hide race - Team has one attempt to make a qualified ride. If rope is dropped and/or person on foot misses the hide your turn is over.
 - Potato Race – make sure the largest piece of potato is in the barrel.
 - Stewards need to make the call and stick to your call
 - Using the baton/ladle/potato stick to hit horse is a 5 second penalty per time
 - Trailer race and pony express – quick cinch maybe used but must be in the original state. No filling off any of it that is a gimmick
 - Water race – if bucket holder crosses the line its 5 second penalty per time.
 - All 4 horses must go before sending the next rider to fill the bottle
 - Ladle must be passed to another rider before going that rider goes again after all four riders have gone
 - Timing is nose to nose

- Stewards make the call when the jar is full
- Pony Express – can't touch other riders horses
 - Saddle must have majority in the circle
- Single Poles – broken pattern is a disqualification
- Keyhole – must go into the neck and turn in the key
 - Step on the line or over line is a 5 second penalty
- Trailer Race – lights should be off before starting the event. Make sure your lights are set to manual
 - Both doors should be shut and lights on when the time stops
 - Door has to be closed not jarred
 - Bit in the horse's mouth
 - Must have saddle, saddle pad and bridle laying flat on the bed of the truck
 - The trailer must be empty
 - A truck is classified as an open cargo bed, often used for personal or commercial use; or flatbed truck- has an open, flat cargo area with no sides or roof
- There is no 30 second warning in arena sorting
- Ribbon Pull- hazer must come out of the heeling box
