

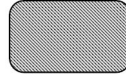

The Kent Boundaries are Established by the 1947 Swift Map

S U M M A R Y

Disputed Property



Only two points are required to prove the original Kent Boundaries in 1947.

1. The Location of the Crescent Brook Cascade.
2. Stake C: an iron pipe discovered in 2013 under a 5" cedar root of two cedar trees traditionally held to mark the beach boundary between Kent and Swift. Documented by surveyor Nathan P. Nadeau, LS [Letter dated 12/11/13]

The conditions at the time of sale in 1947 prevail. All maps and deeds generated after 1947 that contradict the rights and integrity of Kent property represent ineligible reconstructions. The Kent lot is defined by FEC.
