

## 1947 Swift Map Outline



**Finding:** Stake E is located between two boulders, and Stake C [documented] was discovered in 2013 under a 5" root of one of two cedar trees. Extended family member Nancy Duggan, DDS, would testify that Sherrill Kent told her when she was a child that the boundary was at the two cedar trees. The two cedars were known as the boundary to both Kent and Swift families until denied by the Swifts in the early 1990s. In a separate piece of evidence Emerson Swift in a 1971 deed measured a distance of 388.5' from the beach to the false back border. The Horizons Survey reports a distance of 388.1' to the false back border starting from Stake C, i.e. Emerson Swift considered the two cedars to mark the boundary as did Jean Swift Phinney in conversation with Sam Kent in the 1990s.
