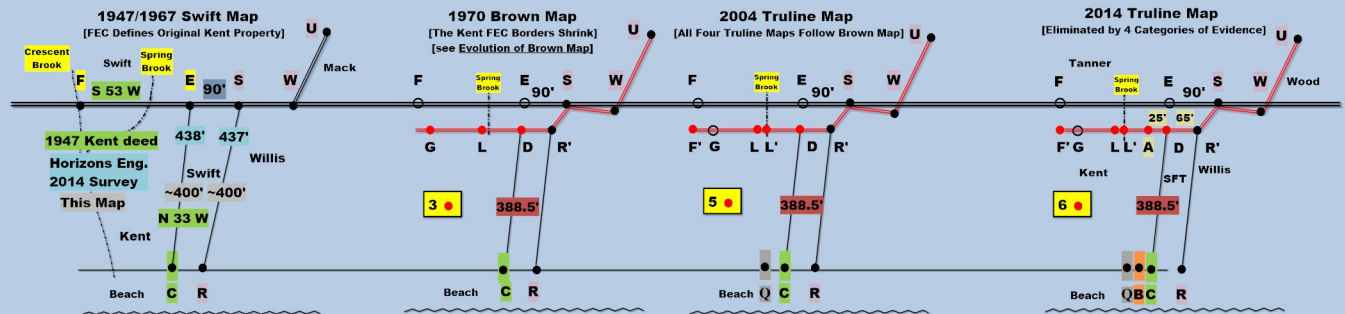

Progression of Four Maps

The 2014 Truline Map is Eliminated by the Flawed 1970 Brown Map

Note: RSWU Anchors All Four Maps



In 1947 Emerson Swift entered "approximately 400 feet" in the 1947 Kent deed and on this map.

● Probably Set in 1947 with C

● Undisputed Stakes set from 1947 to 1951

○ Missing Stakes

● Stakes appearing after 1970

G, L, D appeared in 1970 & 1971 Swift deeds; F is a designated point on the Truline maps. The F'D border & CD = 388.5' is repeated in 1971, 1973a, 1973b & 1988 Swift deeds, all Truline maps, and penciled in on the 1970 Brown Map.

The incriminating 59.5' and stakes F & G disappeared both physically and from the Swift deeds and maps after 1970.

G was also ignored when the lot above F'D was quit claimed to Tanner in 2004. The significance of G [see traverse below] is to reveal the original position of F. Two stakes are required to measure to a tenth of a foot as in 59.5'.

AR' = 25' + 65' = 90' attempts to mimic ES = 90'; it fails with the wedge argument [see below left].

Q was withdrawn by Swift in the Summer of 2012 after it was protested by Sam Kent.

A was discovered by Shane Clark of Truline in the Fall of 2012.

B was then Set by Truline in the Fall or Winter of 2012.

C was discovered by Horizons Eng. under a cedar root of two cedar trees in the Spring of 2013. See Summary for C
