

To obtain the reduced rate you must make your reservation by September 4th. Please call Marriott reservations at 757-425-9000 and request the 459th Association rate.





Robert Williams Barr (September 27, 1924 – November 10, 2018)

Robert Williams Barr died of congestive heart failure at his home in Falcons Landing, Potomac Falls, Virginia, Nov. 10, 2018. Bobby lived most of his early life at Barrsden, on Stony Point Road in Charlottesville, Proffit, along with his parents, James K. and Nancy Barr, and siblings, Nancy, Billy and Jane. He attended Lane High School (graduating from Proctor Academy in Andover, NH in 1943) and the University of Virginia after serving in the Army's Air Force during World War II. He retired a Lt. Col. in 1976.
