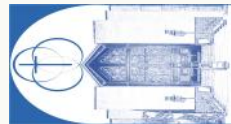

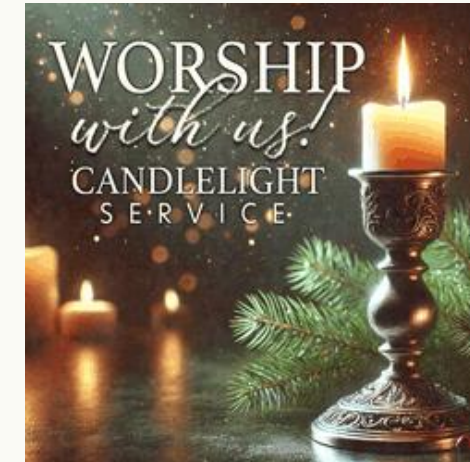

**The church office will be closed for the Christmas Holidays on Wednesday, December 24th @ noon and all day December 25th-26th, December 31st @ noon and January 1st.**

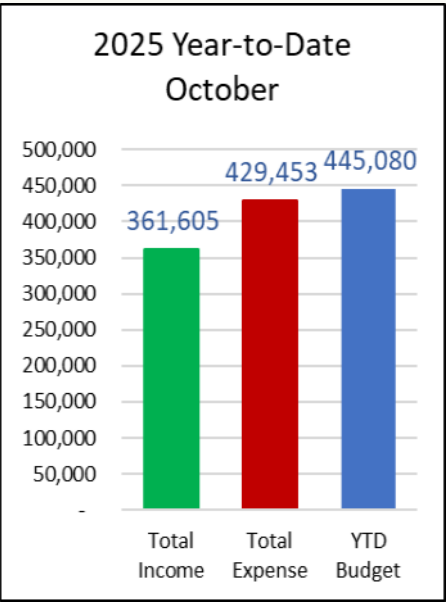
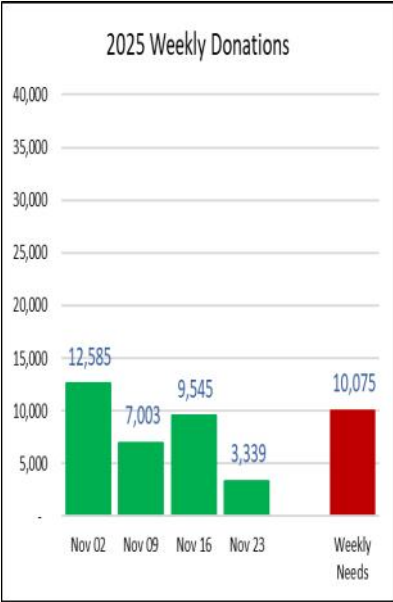
