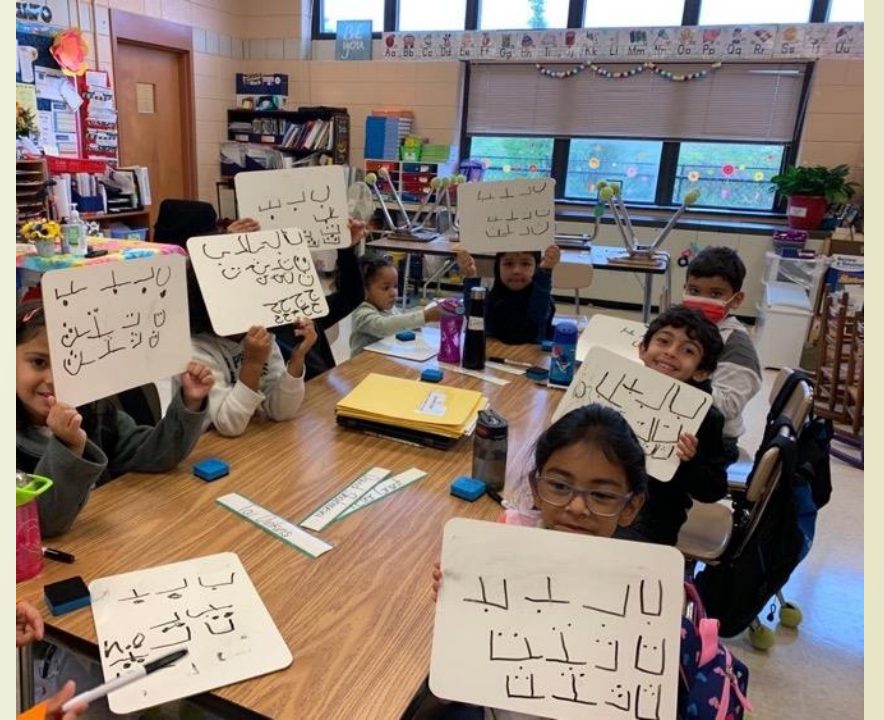


What sets us apart
