MOOSE MEMBERSHIP MOBILE APP

The Moose Membership Mobile App is live on both Google Play and the Apple App Store. Members can now download the app for free using their iPhones or any android phone (i.e., Samsung, Google Pixel, Motorola, etc.). The app includes the new electronic Moose membership card, your Moose membership record, the lodge locator, the General Laws of the Fraternity, as well as instant access to pay dues or sign a new member. Members should use their existing Moose "My Membership Record" user name and password to log in, or register in the app, if they don't have a "My Membership Record" login.

If you are viewing this message on a phone or tablet, the links below will take you directly to the Moose Membership app. If you are viewing this from a computer, it will take you to an information page, but you will not be able to load the app to your phone.





Note: Administrators, volunteers and other individuals tasked with checking Moose membership cards should treat the new electronic membership card the same as the printed card. The membership expiration date is in the same location as on the printed card. The electronic card is almost identical to the printed card, however, if a member is marked as a Valued Veteran, the card will carry the VV design. Also, the electronic card does NOT have a magnetic strip, but rather a QR code instead, so members will still need to carry their printed card if their lodge has a mag strip reader on the entrance door that has not yet been upgraded with a QR code reader. 

MEMBERSHIP

Here we are, one month into the new year. I hope all is going well for you and you are dealing with your "New Year's Resolutions;" or not, as the case may be. Several of us attended the Virginia Moose Association Mid-year conference last month. It was a time to renew past acquaintances and meet some new ones. The usual reports about the various programs and happenings were presented. One of the normal topics for discussion is always membership and our membership numbers. The Moose fraternity seems to be doing well this year and the Virginia Moose Association (VMA) is also doing well.

As a Lodge, 1655 seems to be on track to meet our membership goals as well. Our total membership numbers seem to be steady and most of the reminders for renewal seem to be fruitful. Our new application numbers could use some work though. Two of the requirements for the Premier Lodge Award are directly tied to our membership and application numbers. In the last few years, we have come up short in these areas. Our goal for new applications this year is 258. That means that by the end of the Moose year we need to have that many applications completed, approved, voted upon, and processed. The Moose year ends on April 30th. The latest report from the VMA shows that we are currently at 201. We need 57 more applications by the end of the Moose year. That is three more months. Our current trend should bring us close but possibly not over the goal. We need your best efforts to recruit and sponsor your friends, work associates, and family members.

Our total membership numbers look good, and we are currently over the goal. We cannot relax on this though because if we have a month of light renewals, it will take away from our total numbers. Historically, March has always been the worst month for renewals. It seems that many of our members have March renewal dates and wait for a while to complete the renewal process. If you have a March renewal, I would suggest that you renew now. Additionally, if you have sponsored someone around this time last year, reach out to them. Encourage them to renew early. Remember that you cared enough for them to sponsor them into our Lodge, and you should care enough to remind them to renew.

Paying your renewal dues is not difficult at all. You can always use the mail to send it in. You can also pay right at the Social Quarters. It is also easily done online at the Moose International website (www.mooseintl.org). You can even renew for more than one year. Renewing early does not impact your next renewal date because your anniversary will always be the same. Besides, then you won't be left in arrears and not be able to enjoy your Moose privileges.
