From the President

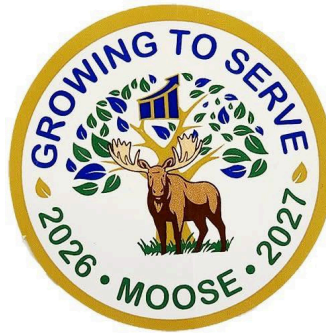

FELLOWSHIP / PILGRAM COMMITTEE

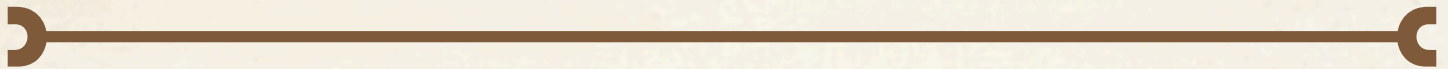
