# MOOSE LEGION COMMITTEE

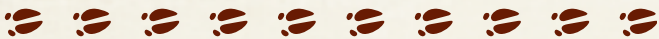

## FELLOWSHIP / PILGRIM COMMITTEE



Often the question is asked, "what do I have to do to become a Fellow?" Well, over the years that answer has changed several times. However, the biggest change is now it is actually listed and allowed to be discussed. For years, it was hidden in secrecy. The most current information can be found on [www.mooseintl.org](http://www.mooseintl.org), but I will make it known here as we begin the new Moose year.

A member must meet five basic qualifications in order to be eligible for consideration for the Fellowship Degree of Honor:

- He must hold active membership in a Lodge and a Moose Legion.
- He must have been a member of the Lodge for at least five (5) consecutive years, or three (3) consecutive years if he is a charter member.
- He must have been a member of the Moose Legion for at least one (1) year.
- He must have sponsored five (5) members during his Moose career, with one (1) application sponsored during the previous 12 months that has been accepted in LCL; or he must be a member of the Moose 25 Club.
- He must have sponsored one (1) Moose Legion application during his Moose career that has been accepted in LCL.

In addition to the five mandatory criteria, a member must satisfy eight (8) of the following twelve (12) items:

- Be a member of the Moose 25 Club
- If a Moose 25 Club member, attain membership in a higher division
- Served as an elected or appointed lodge officer for at least five (5) full years
- Served as or currently serving as Lodge President
- Served at least one (1) year as or currently serving as Lodge Administrator
- Served at least one (1) year as a Lodge Committee Chairman
- Served the State/Provincial Moose Association as an elected or appointed officer for at least one (1) full term (District President counts toward this item)
- Served at least one (1) year on a Moose Legion jurisdiction's Board of Directors
- Attained the \$100 level of the Donors Circle program
- Achieved membership in the Moose Charities League of Guardians
- Confirmed as a qualified trainer by the Moose International Training Department
- Attending the International Moose Convention within the previous ten (10) years

Reports are run each month to determine members who have achieved the necessary criteria for elevation. These reports are reviewed by the Territory Manager of the member's primary Lodge, as well as the Moose International Compliance Office, to assure there are no disciplinary concerns. Once these reviews have been completed, the individual will receive a call to appear for conferral, provided no issues have been identified. Those members who qualify during the months of July through March will receive their initial call to appear for the conferral that will take place during the next International Moose Convention. Those who qualify during the months of April, May, or June will receive their initial call to the conferral that will take place at their respective Association Conventions. In either instance, a member will only receive four calls to appear for conferral. If they do not appear after four (4) calls, they will not receive another opportunity. The next meeting for the Fellowship/Pilgrim Committee will be held on **4 June at 7 pm**. Our next breakfast will be held on **14 June from 8 to 11 am**. Speaking of breakfast. Last month we saw a massive turnout for Mother's Day. We did our very best to plan accordingly and not run out of anything, but with 20 minutes or so till 11, we had to break out the emergency taters. We ran out of country ham, sausage gravy, and sausage patties. I think the last order went out about 11:20 am. We thank you for your patience on these busy days. We could always use more volunteers.

Speaking of volunteers. Do you enjoy all the perks of being a member of 1655? 90% of it all is put on by volunteers. While we grow our membership, it seems that it's the same 25-30 volunteers that put on all these events. We need your help! Many of us have been doing this for 20 years, and we aren't getting any younger. Out of a Lodge that boasts 1800 + members, about 2% are stepping up to make things happen. If you wish to continue to enjoy the perks that the Lodge offers, we need new volunteers.
