



Scholarship Application Process

The Atlanta Society of Muslim Men cordially invites graduating high school seniors who plan to attend college to apply for the ASMM scholarship. The scholarship amount can be up to \$1000. The information below explains the requirements for eligibility and the application process. We pray for Allah's blessings upon all high school graduating seniors in his/her academic pursuit.

Eligibility:

Any graduating high school senior, who is a Muslim, within the community associated with Imam W. D. Mohammed and attending any high school in the metropolitan Atlanta area, with a grade point average of at least 3.0 are eligible to apply. Each applicant must also satisfactorily complete the required application process.

Application Process:

Applicants are required to submit an essay of 300 words or less that concisely answers the following questions:

- What do you plan to study in college and why?
- How do you plan to use your education to give back to the Atlanta Masjid community?
- What in your character and/or special abilities differentiate you from your peers?
- Why do you believe that you should receive an ASMM scholarship?
- Please submit your complete mailing address, phone number, and email address with your application.

You are also required to have two letters of recommendation submitted to the ASMM from a faculty member from your high school and from another non-related adult. Have your school send a verifiable copy of your official transcript to the ASMM. All of the above mentioned supporting documents are required to be submitted to the ASMM via email no later than March 31st. Eligible applicants will be contacted to schedule an in-person or virtual interview.

Notification:

Scholarship recipients will receive notification by April 30.
