- Collaborate with BCBA to build positive therapeutic relationships with clients and caregivers through
 effective communication regarding concerns, progress, and/or treatment
- Frequently communicate with BCBA regarding client concerns, progress, and/or treatment
- Assist with implementing parent and caregiver training protocols
- Carry out designated administrative duties
- Ensure that all required documentation is completed in a timely manner and in compliance with organizational procedures
- Implement toilet training protocols when applicable
- Maintain client confidentiality
- Maintain a clean, safe, and organized therapy environment
- Ongoing compliance with the Code of Ethics set forth by the Behavior Analyst Certification Board (BACB)
