Why do crabs never volunteer? – Because they are shell-fish

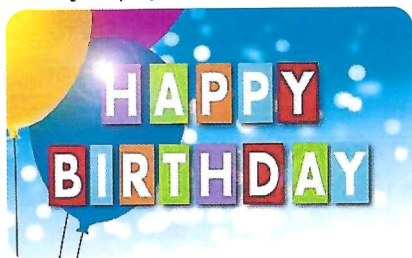
