Uniontown, PA – The Fayette County Board of Elections has been advised by the Pennsylvania Department of State that the Department of State inadvertently transferred the 2024 voter file to be downloaded for the electronic pollbooks in Fayette County instead of the 2025 file. All Fayette County precincts have been instructed to switch to their backup paper pollbooks at this time.

If you encountered this error and were unable to vote, please return to your precinct to cast your ballot. Any provisional ballot cast because of this error will be counted.
