A message from our Board Chair



Dear Friends and Partners,

On behalf of the Community Dental Clinic's Board of Trustees, I am proud to share our 2024 – 2025 annual report of the work we did throughout our past fiscal year October 2024 – September 2025. Every additional year the clinic is serving the community with dental care is a new milestone in our history. This year was no exception.

The clinic provided \$2,328,299 in dental services—a 7% increase over the previous year. We saw seven new patients per week and ten urgent care visits per week. The average value of dental services per patient provided was \$743. We continue to strive to build smiles and lasting habits of good oral care while also taking care of the emergencies that are referred to us through many community partnerships.

In addition to our core services this year, we participated in the BayCare Critical Smiles program providing dental services to those patients needing medical clearance to proceed with cancer treatment. Patients that require orthopedic and cardiology procedures experience the same hurdle to care without a clean oral health clearance. We are working to broaden our impact in this area. In October, 2025, we engaged in the Ryan White Program, partnering with St. Joseph Hospital and Pinellas County to supplement dental treatment to HIV patients with dental care that exceeds what the county can provide. Looking ahead, we will continue to widen our scope of services to encompass overall oral health by expanding partnerships, patient experiences, volunteer participation and outside dental programs.

After twelve years of dedicated service in the Clearwater police substation on Woodlawn Avenue, we reached a historic milestone on August 4, 2025. We moved into our forever home located at 1390 S. Missouri Avenue, Clearwater. Our new state-of-the-art facility is 6,500 square feet featuring nine dental operatories, an advanced sterilization center, wet and dry lab technology and a community room. Through the extraordinary generosity of The Ruth & J O Stone Foundation, our community partners and the unwavering support of our donors, we moved to our building debt-free. Our new facility only strengthens our ability to expand our patient base and community outreach. If you missed our Open House, please call and schedule a tour of the clinic.

As we are adapting and adjusting in our new facility, we also welcome some new board members and staff. It is with great appreciation and excitement that we welcome Michael Clarke and Dan Shoby to our Board of Trustees. Our clinical staff has grown to include a second full-time, on-staff dentist, Marissa Albert, DDS. Dr. Albert joins us three years out of dental school with a passion for our patients and exceptional dental work and works along side Dr. Dan Salvatore and our volunteer dentists. Our executive staff has changed to include Jennifer Whittington, Executive Director. Jennifer joins us with many years of non-profit leadership and community engagement.

Thank you for standing with us during this transformative year. None of this would be possible without our staff, board, committed volunteers and donors who also share in our mission. Together, we are keeping the momentum moving and look forward to another exciting year!

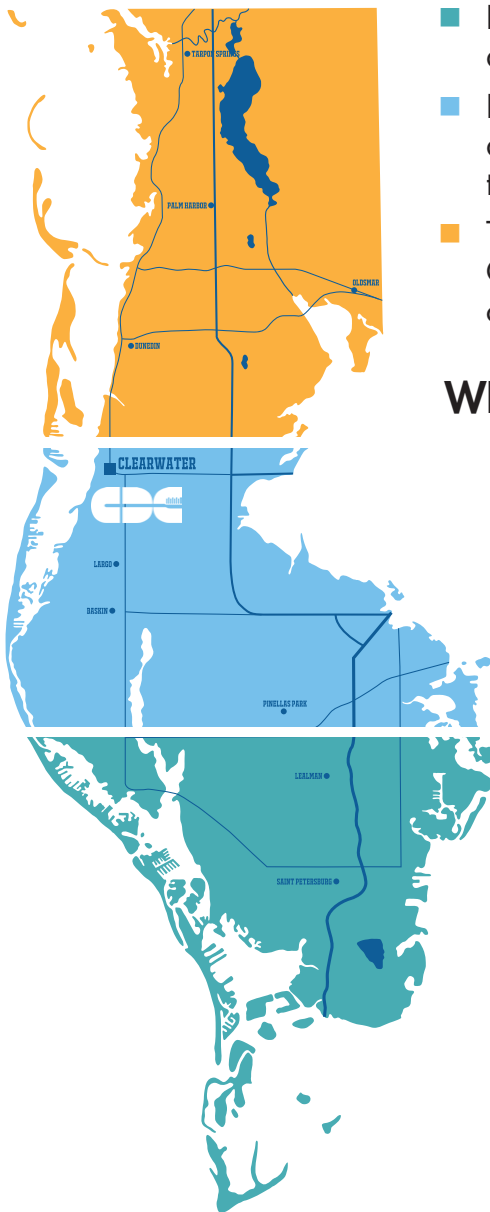

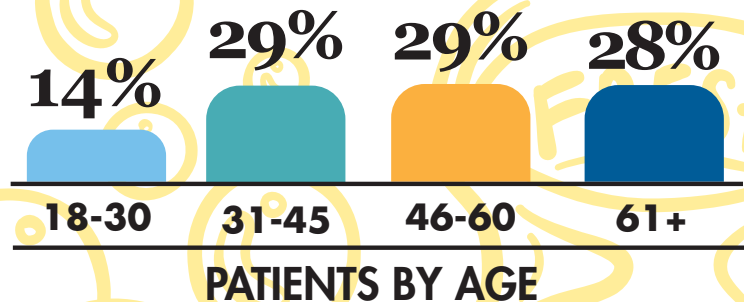
Access to Care

The Community Dental Clinic is strategically located in the heart of Pinellas County, ensuring convenient access for the diverse patients we serve. Situated on Missouri Avenue in Clearwater, a major north-south corridor, the clinic is reachable by a wide range of transportation options. Patients from nearby neighborhoods may walk, bike, or use rideshare services, while others travel by public transit, personal vehicle, or with the support of family and friends. This central and accessible location helps reduce transportation barriers and strengthens our ability to provide essential dental care to low-income, uninsured individuals throughout the county.

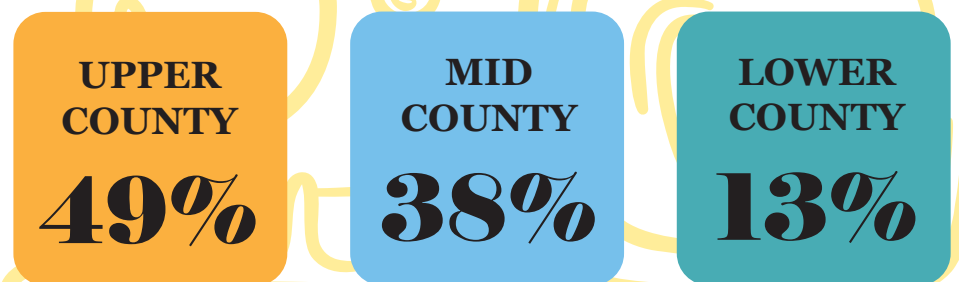


- Florida ranks 43 out of 50 states for adults with an annual dental visit.
- In Pinellas County, 37% of low-income adults are eligible for our services and most likely lack traditional dental care.
- The uninsured population, 28.6% of Pinellas County (or 23,000 residents), may lack comprehensive dental coverage.

Access to dental care is essential for overall health and well-being. Untreated oral health issues can lead to pain, infection, tooth loss, difficulty eating and speaking, and can contribute to broader health concerns. Many low-income and uninsured adults face significant barriers to receiving care, including cost, lack of insurance, and limited access to providers. Community Dental Clinic plays a vital role in closing this gap by providing no cost, accessible dental services that relieve pain, restore health, and improve quality of life. Beyond oral health, this care supports confidence, employability, and daily functioning, helping adults live healthier and more stable lives.

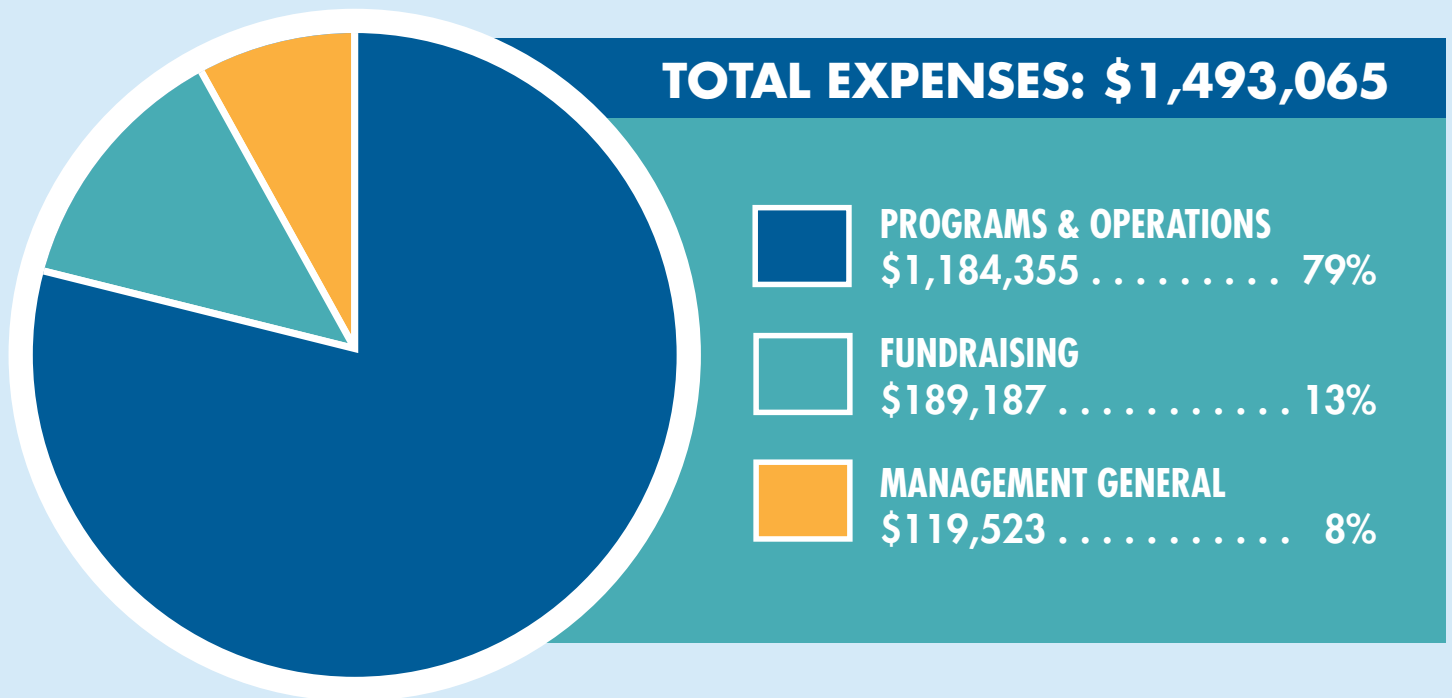
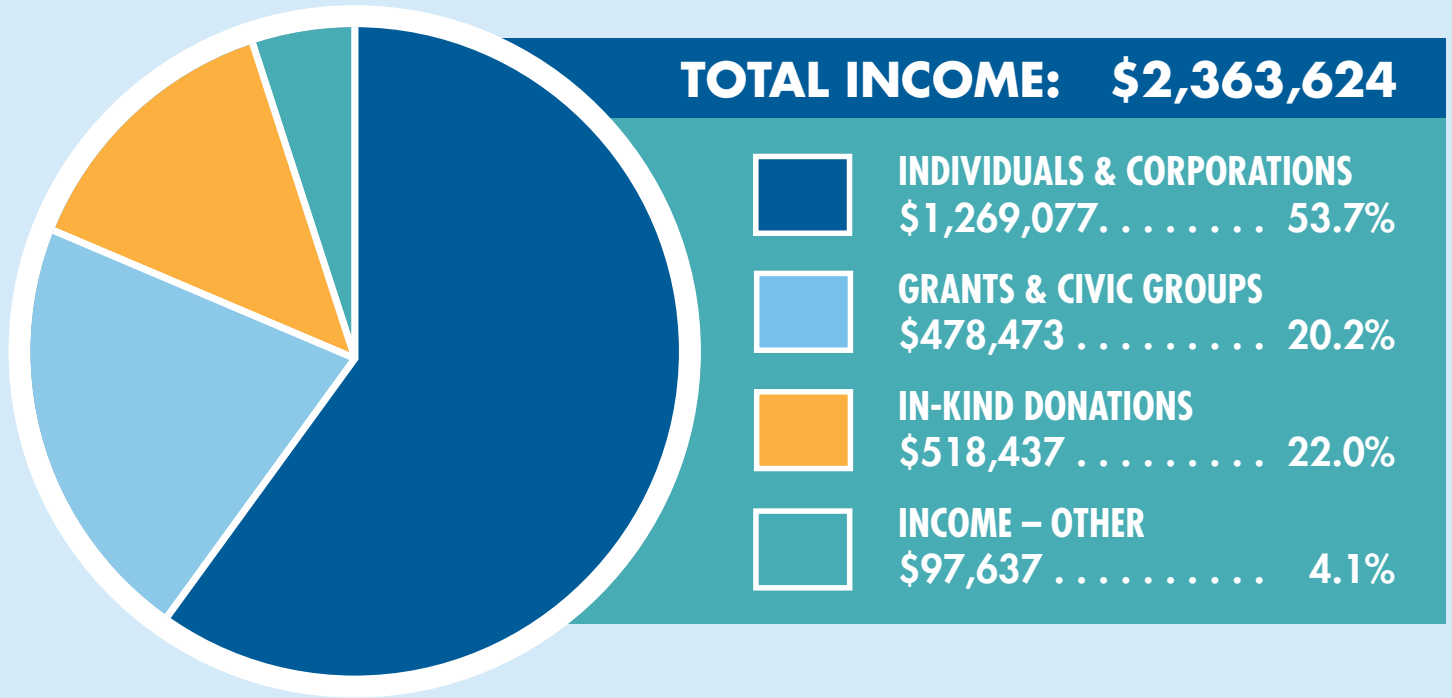

After 13 years in the Clearwater Police Substation on Woodlawn Avenue in Clearwater, we moved to our new state-of-the-art facility. Finding the property and completing the project was a 5-year endeavor. The construction committee along with community partners working together helped us realize our dream.

August 4, 2025 marks a milestone date as we moved into our forever home. Upon move-in, we were able to furnish 7 of 9 dental operatories expanding our space to accommodate more patients. As we grow into our larger facility, we are working to complete furnishing rooms, acquire additional supplies and instruments, and expand our volunteer base and staffing while meeting the increasing demand for dental care among uninsured, low-income adults in Pinellas County—all positive signs of our growing impact.
