



Going Forward

Recognize offender tactics that affect the victim's ability to participate in investigations and prosecutions.

Prepare for unique challenges, such as violence witnessed by children and predominant aggressor determinations.

Consider and weigh the impact of prosecution decisions on victims, communities, and the interests of justice.
