Game watched continue at Arooga's. Scores for Scholars, your monetary donations collected after our Nittany Lions score, has raised nearly \$400 towards our

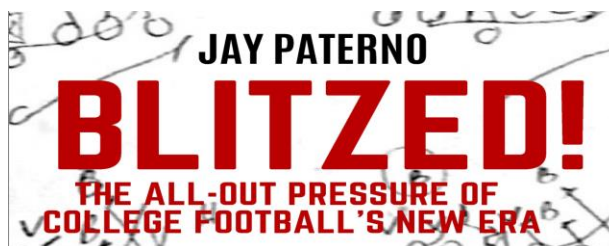
scholarship fund. Thank you for your generosity.
