About: Hello and welcome! This event is designed to be a fun Family friendly event! We want to see friends and family come together and have a great time camping and competing if you so wish with their equines!

Our Judge: Jennifer Sawyer- A multi carded judge with 30 plus years of experience, and a nationally recognized clinician. She is a very friendly and compassionate woman who helps many people with their equine journeys.

In Hand Obstacle Challenge : Designed for you to show off how well you and your horse work together in hand. You will compete with your horse in hand with halter and lead rope over a series of 6-7 Obstacles. Obstacles could be anything from sending through, over , and under , walking/trotting/halting/backing/ turning alongside your horse to noise sensitivity.

Under saddle Obstacle Challenge: Designed for you to show off how well you and your horse work together under saddle. You will compete riding your horse over a series of 6-7 Obstacles. Obstacles could be anything from sending through, over , and under , walking/trotting/halting/backing/ turning alongside your horse to noise sensitivity.

Poker Ride : This can be done many ways. But we will have 5 Miles of Trails Marked with 7 stops where you will pick up different colored poker chips at each stop. (you can reach them from the saddle) When you come back to camp you cash in your poker chips for cards. You can throw two out and the one with the best hand WINS!

Camping & Stalls:

Electric and primitive sites available. Camping is NOT included in the entry fee. Electric sites MUST be reserved & paid for in advance through McCulley Farms or no guarantee one will be available for you. Camping is paid directly to McCulley Farms.

Ride Camp Amenities:

Hot showers and restroom facilities are available at a couple locations in Base Camp. Water is available in camp at many locations. All dogs must be on a leash at all times — No Exceptions! No pets allowed in the food/entertainment area (Barn #4).

Make neighborhood manure piles for collection after the ride by the McCulleys. If you have used your stall, you need to strip any bedding to avoid a stall cleaning fee; put all bagged trash in the stock trailer outside of Barn #4. Remember that each horse owner/rider is responsible for the safe camping/restraint of their horse.

Liability Release Form : ALL guests need to sign the release of liability form, not just the rider upon check in.

Trails: Trails are on both state and private land. The terrain is mainly flat with good dirt/grass footing. This is Florida, so there is a little deep sand (no long stretches of deep sand). Shoes not required.

Ride Start Times:

We will have sign up times for all events (Poker ride, in hand, and under saddle obstacle challenges) to keep minimal horse traffic and to keep families and friends competing/riding together and cheering each other on!

Rules: Helmets are required for ALL youth riders whenever in the saddle. For in-hand and under saddle we will be following 4-H Rules. For on Trial you must be kind to others and pass at a walk if passing in another group.

Age Divisions:

Youngin' - up to 10 years old, Junior — 11 to 18, Adult- 18 and up

Riding Divisions:

Walk (Beginner), Walk/Trot (Novice), Talk/trot/Canter (Intermediate)

Registration: Pre- Registration is encouraged so we can plan for a smooth running event.

Check in will be on Friday from 5-6PM and Saturday Morning from 7-8AM

Ride Starts Promptly at 9AM.

Food:

Breakfast: Coffee bar in Barn 4 in the morning with registration.

Lunch: bring your lunch (from 12-1 we will have a break)

Dinner : There will be a dinner in barn 4. You can pre purchase your BBQ feast or bring your own and join us.

Awards: 1-6th in all riding divisions. Highpoint in each Age Division. If you cannot stay for awards, please arrange for someone to pick up for you. No awards will be mailed out.

Highpoint: for all riding divisions. You have to do all three events, you get 100 points for the porker ride and then the average of all three scores determines the Grand and Reserve Champion.

Volunteers: Help is always appreciated. Volunteers camping is paid for and meals.

Directions: (you can use google maps, but do **NOT** use map quest as it is not correct)

From the North: I-75 S to exit 467 — CR 143. Go South/West 8.8 miles. McCulley Farms will be on your right.

From the South: I-75 N to exit 460 — SR6 (Madison/Jasper). Go West on SR 6 for 10.7 miles and turn right on CR143 (you will see a left turn for CR143 about a mile prior; ignore the left turn and continue on SR 6 another mile to the right-hand turn). McCulley Farms is 1.3 miles down on the left.

CANCELLATION / REFUND POLICY: No refund for meals. Camping refunds are to go through McCulley Farms Directly. Full refund for Ride entry through Monday May 23rd, 2022 at noon minus \$15 admin fee. Full refund through Thursday May 26th, at noon, minus \$25 admin fee.

Important: In addition to a current negative Coggins issued within the past 12 months, Florida Law requires a current health certificate on all out of state livestock. All trailers must stop at agricultural inspection stations.
